# **Council Action**

Discussion and Action on a Resolution providing \$1,000,000 be allocated to the U.S. Economic Development Administration (EDA) Fiscal Year 2024 Build to Scale (B2S) Program for the El Paso Technology Infrastructure Cooperative (Project) from the Impact Fund and authorizing the City of El Paso to support the Medical Center of the America's application through the City of El Paso's Business One-Stop Shop (BOSS).

# **B2S Overview**

- 1. Up to \$5,000,000 in Federal funds per award
- 2. Aims to increase the capacity of entrepreneurs to demonstrate, deploy, and deliver new technologies by starting and growing new companies and creating and sustaining new, good jobs.
- 3. Applicants must provide at least a 50% match


