



Knowledge: Spent 13 years as a US Navy Wife, while husband was on active duty. While we were stationed at NAS Atsugi, Japan, I was selected Ombudsman of the Squadron. I met with the Commander or Executive Officer and discussed families and their concerns. We provided families with information regarding squadron events and happenings via a monthly newsletter. While ship (USS Independence) was out to sea, I received a call from the Commander and he would inform me, whenever possible, what port and dates the ship would dock, as well as any emergencies that required his or my intervention. Most of the information was confidential and required opsec (operation security). Our squadron families learned to trust each and support one another, as we became extended family members to our respective families.

Skills: During our time in the Navy, I learned about resources and what was available to help our families. There is a certain skill that is required to gain the trust of families and the trust of the service members. The main objective was to keep families informed with respect and understanding that every problem or situation was different and was handled with urgency and discretion.

Abilities: Becoming a resource coordinator and the ability to direct families to the correct person or agency that can or could provide information needed is crucial. During the last twenty years, I have become an active member with the Veterans of Foreign Wars. my experience as an Auxiliary Past President, Secretary at Post 4380 in Plano, TX.
