Interlocal Cooperation Contract

Code Enforcement Department

House Bill 2844

- Created a state wide issued mobile food vendor license
- All oversight will be through the Department of State Health Services
- Prevents municipalities from requiring a local food permit
- Allows for a collaborative agreement with local municipalities
- Takes effect July 1, 2026

Scope of Work

- Pre licensing Inspections
- Routine Inspections
- Complaint Investigations
- Investigate reported Foodborne Illnesses

Mobile Food Vendor Types

Type I

- Prepackaged food, No Time/Temperature Controlled for Safety (TCS) foods

Type II

- Dispensed food that requires limited handling and preparation

Type III

- Prepares, cooks, holds, and serves from vehicle

Inspection Reimbursements

- \$250 for the inspection of a Type I Mobile Food Vendor
- \$350 for the inspection of Type II Mobile Food Vendor
- \$400 for the inspection of Type III Mobile Food Vendor



Contract Period and Renewal

- Effective July 1, 2026 and terminates August 31, 2027
- May extend agreement up to 4 additional years for a maximum of 5 years
- The contract shall not exceed \$357,347.00
