Ordinance Amending Title 12.88.180

Purpose of Amendment

CID & International Bridges requested Streets and Maintenance to restrict parking on Rio Del Norte to facilitate the flow of truck traffic into the POE and regular traffic into Loop 375.

Parking restriction will allow for designated turning lanes at the intersection of the Zaragoza International Truck Bridge and Rio Del Norte Drive.

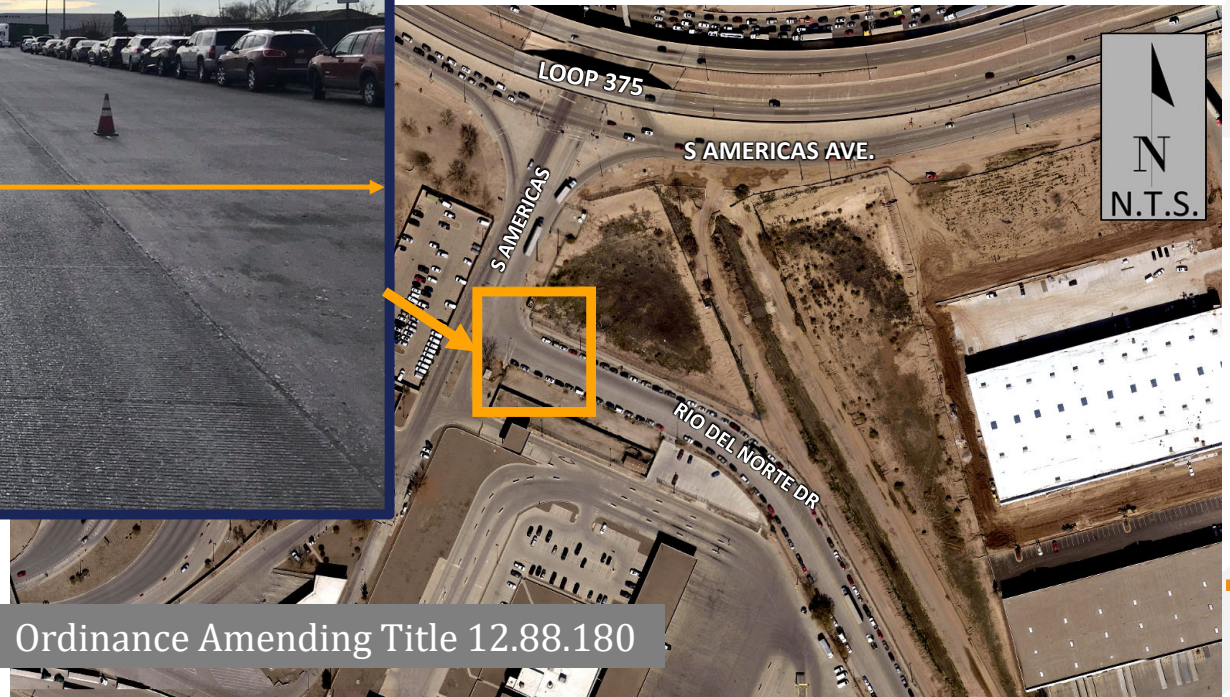
Parking restriction limits on Rio Del Norte:

- From S. Americas Avenue (commonly known as the Ysleta-Zaragoza International Truck Bridge) to 400 feet east of Playa Norte Drive, north side only.
- From S. Americas Avenue (commonly known as the entrance to the Ysleta-Zaragoza International Truck Bridge) to 330 feet east, south side only.

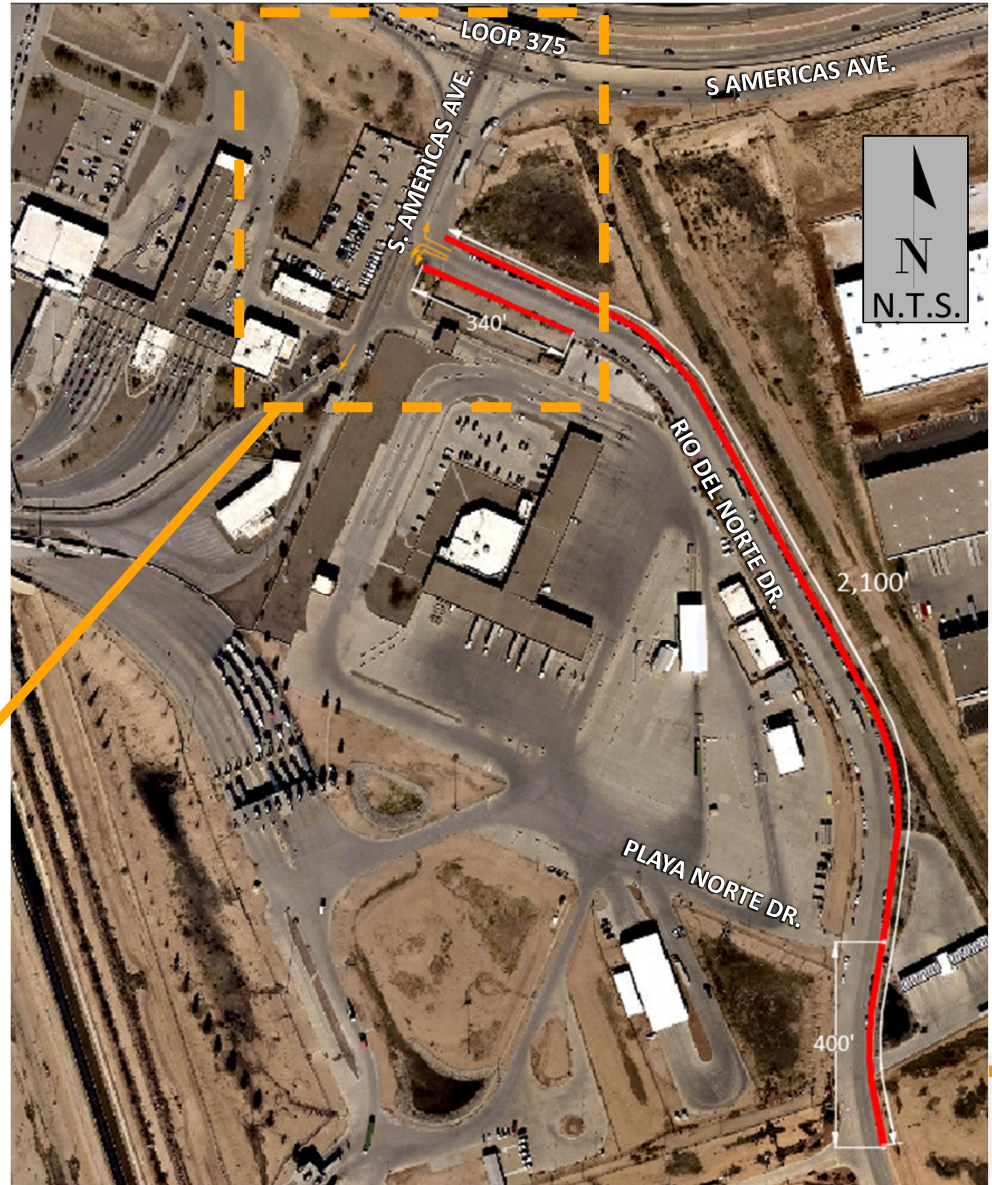
Existing Conditions – Rio Del Norte Street View

Requested Council Action

Via Ordinance, amend Title 12, Chapter 12.88 (Schedules), Section 12.88.180 (No stopping or standing–Tow-away zone), Paragraph A, to add portions of Rio Del Norte Drive; the penalty being provided in Section 12.84 of the El Paso City Code.

Add:

117. Rio Del Norte, from S. Americas Avenue (commonly known as the Ysleta-Zaragoza International Truck Bridge) to 400 feet east of Playa Norte Drive, north side only.
118. Rio Del Norte, from S. Americas Avenue (commonly known as the Ysleta-Zaragoza International Truck Bridge) to 330 feet east, south side only.

Staff recommends approval.
