

INTERNATIONAL BRIDGES LEGISLATIVE STRATEGY

Bills and Policy Actions

- Introduce Land Ports Development Grant Program (LPDGP) Bill with Congresswoman Escobar in 2026
- Pass the International Bridge and Port of Entry Modernization (IBEM) Act of 2025 with Congressman Gonzales and Senator Cruz included in Senate version of the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA)
- Opportunity Zone designations in Census Tracts adjacent to Paso del Norte, Stanton, and Ysleta Ports of Entry
- Request Federal Rulemaking changes in USDOT / FWHA funding programs to allow international ports projects to compete favorably against other transportation projects

INTERNATIONAL POLICY ACTIONS

Expand Binational Coordination (2025-2026)

- Request the Government of Mexico to include the Ysleta Zaragoza Port in planning documents
- Launch El Paso Ports Taskforce (MATT) with the U.S. Department of State, CBP, ANAM, Chihuahua State, City of El Paso, Juarez Municipality, NMBA, EP County
- Continue engaging maquiladora industry groups (CCE, CANACINTRA, UACJ) to formalize advocacy support for the Ysleta Zaragoza Port
- Support Juarez Municipality in making short term improvements to Zaragoza
 Port ingress and egress roads and connections to highways

EL PASO PORTS TASKFORCE (MATT)

Goal: Increase binational communication and develop short and long term solutions to regional cross border traffic.

- Short term goal: Mitigate impact of BOTA commercial closure
- Long term goal: Design ports for improved and sustainable use in POV and commercial traffic based on user needs. Develop projects in similar timelines and invest with knowledge of future plans for all POE.
