


## **Public Health & Safety**

# General Legislative Principles


### We Support:

- The enhancement and protection of municipal authority.

## We Oppose:

 The reduction of municipal authority, increased costs to taxpayers, undermining of the home rule principle, unfunded mandates, and municipal ordinance-making authority.





# Texas Municipal League Priorities


- Bills regarding zoning preemption and land use are anticipated to restrict municipal authority
  - Example: HB 878
- Will oppose bills that reduce or remove ETJs
- Will support bills that remove the reauthorization of street and maintenance fee provision requirements
