AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 2 (ADMINSTRATION AND PERSONNEL), CHAPTER 2.20 (BOARDS OF PARKS AND RECREATION), TO REMOVE REFERENCES AND LANGUAGE REGARDING THE PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD IN CHAPTER 2.20.

**WHEREAS,** the El Paso City Council establishes City Boards and Commissions to inform City Council under statutory authorization or on particular issues or subjects of interest to the Council; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of El Paso recognizes the importance of consistent governance and operational procedures across all city boards and commissions to ensure efficient and effective public administration; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 12, 2025, City Council directed boards and commissions be standardized to be enacted by resolution instead of ordinance; and

**WHEREAS,** by Ordinance No. 017124 the El Paso City Council codified the creation of the Board of Parks and Recreation (the "Board") to advise the Mayor and City Council on improvement and development of parks and recreation facilities, services, and programs and to promote close cooperation between the City and all private citizens, institutions, and agencies interested in the establishment and development of parks and recreation activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

**SECTION 1**. That El Paso City Code Title 2 (ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL), Chapter 2.20 (BOARDS OF PARKS AND RECREATION) is hereby repealed so as to read as follows:

Chapter 2.20 – Reserved.

**SECTION 2.** Except as expressly herein amended, all other provisions of the El Paso City Code will remain in full force and effect. The requirements of this ordinance will take effect 90 days from its adoption and publication in accordance with and as provided by law and the City Charter.
