# Contract Scope of Work

The purpose of this contract is to obtain design services for the Playa Drain Shared Use Path Project

The consultant will provide design services for the following project scope:

- Shared Use Path running along the Playa drain, Knights Dr., and Midway Dr. from Yarbrough Dr. to Alameda Ave. and Mimosa Ave.
- Pedestrian Illumination
- Parkway Improvements
- Pedestrian crossing improvements
- ADA compliant sidewalks, driveways and ADA ramps
- Landscape as per City requirements
- Pedestrian amenities

# Procurement Summary

Selection process was qualifications based through the City's A/E Selection Process.

- **Request for Qualification advertised on August 8, 2025**
  - 8 firms submitted statements of qualifications
- **Recommended Actions**
  - To award contract to the highest qualified firm, GFT Infrastructure, Inc.

**Contract Amount:** Project specific agreement will be for an amount not to exceed \$599,767.96

**A resolution that the City Manager be authorized to sign an Agreement for Professional Services by and between the CITY OF EL PASO and GFT Infrastructure, Inc., a professional limited liability company, for a project known as “Playa Drain Shared Path Use Project” for an amount not to exceed \$599,767.96; that the City Engineer is authorized to approve additional Basic Services and Reimbursables for an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 and to approve Additional Services for an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 if such services are necessary for the proper execution of the project and that the increased amounts are within the appropriate budgets of the project for a total amount of \$699,767.96**
