

Ysleta POE Pedestrian Improvements Design Contract Amendment

March 3, 2026



Background

- The City seeks to amend the Professional Services contract for the Ysleta Port of Entry Pedestrian Improvements project to include design services for a Sun Metro canopy expansion at the existing stop on Loop 375 and a new pedestrian toll booth building.
- Council approved a RAISE Grant Agreement with the US Department of Transportation on May 7, 2024.
- The additional services will include additional design requirements and submittals to meet federal requirements.

Recommendations

- That the City Manager is authorized to sign a First Amendment to the Agreement for Professional Services between City and Consultant whereby Consultant shall provide additional services to the City
 - Additional total cost: \$165,662.32
 - Local Participation for Additional Services: \$31,475.84
 - New contract amount: \$1,271,326.84
 - Additional cost is within the existing project budget
