# Background

- ★ On Nov. 5, 2019, voters approved the \$74.4M Public Safety Bond, funding renovations at 34 fire stations, including Station #8
- ★ On May 4, 2020, Alvidrez Architecture was engaged under the 2019 On-Call Architectural Services to assess Station #8
- ★ On July 7, 2020, a report was delivered recommending full renovation: replacement of MEP systems, lighting, plumbing fixtures, power/data, doors, flooring, finishes, and site improvements










## **SCOPE OF WORK**

- Modernization of power and data infrastructure
