Agenda Item	A resolution authorizing the City Manager to apply for and submit to the Department of Homeland Security/FEMA a grant application for the City of El Paso Fire Department project identified as FY 2025 Fire Prevention and Safety ("FP&S") Integrated Fire Investigation and Community Risk Reduction Program to provide financial assistance to the City of El Paso in the amount of \$383,649.67 with a cash match of \$19,182.48 to a total grant amount of \$402,832.15.
Issue Statement	The City of El Paso Fire Department is seeking funding through the FY25 Fire Prevention and Safety (FP&S) Integrated Fire Investigation and Community Risk Reduction Program to purchase critical equipment for both the Community Risk Reduction Division and the Fire Arson Investigations Division. Funding will support the expansion and enhancement of smoke and carbon monoxide detector programs throughout the community, particularly for vulnerable and high-risk populations and will also strengthening the Fire Arson Investigation Division's capabilities through the acquisition of specialized investigative equipment (trailer).
Background	The FP&S program intends to enhance the safety of the public and firefighters with respect to fire and fire-related hazards by assisting fire prevention programs and supporting firefighter health and safety research and development. Grant funds are available in two activities: Fire Prevention and Safety Activity and Research and Development Activity.
