Background

- 2007 Ordinance established Municipal Drainage Utility System, for the collection, management and control of storm water runoff to protect health, safety and welfare of the citizens of El Paso.
- Ordinance required a Master Stormwater Management Plan, which was prepared and approved by City Council in 2009.
- Ordinance also required an annual Stormwater Capital Improvement Plan (Capital Plan) which would include the use and maintenance of arroyos and other natural drainage systems to manage stormwater.
- Annual Capital Plan required to identify stormwater infrastructure projects (including land acquisitions) which have the potential dual purpose of stormwater management and preservation of City's open spaces, greenways, arroyos and wilderness areas in their natural state.
- Ten percent (10%) of the System's annual drainage utility fee revenue shall be allocated for such Green Projects.
