Background

 On March 28, 2023, City Council approved a Ground Lease Agreement for the lease of approximately 206 acres of land managed and controlled by the El Paso International Airport.



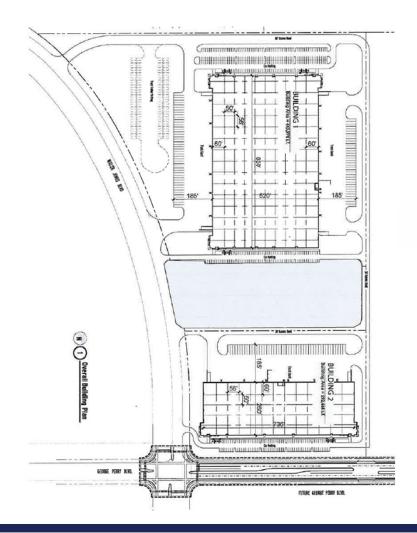
Basic Lease Terms

- Type of Lease: Ground Lease
- **Tenant**: ELP Land Holdings I, LLC
- Size of Land: Approximately 206 acres
- Term: 40 year, 9 year option
- Annual Rent after construction of all phases: \$1,730,639.63
- Allowed Uses: Light Manufacturing, Logistics, Warehousing
- **Build Out**: 4 phases. Phase one will include two buildings totaling 636,422 Square Feet.









Phase 1 Site Plan

Construction expected to commence September 2025.



Previous Council Actions

- March 28, 2023 City Council Approval of Ground Lease
- November 7, 2023 City Council Approval of First Amendment to Ground Lease Agreement
 - Corrected square footage to account for water well on property
 - Extended rent commencement period from April 6, 2025 to July 5, 2025
 - Extended due diligence period by additional 90 days



Request for Second Amendment

Requesting approval of Second Amendment to accommodate for delays in entitlements, utilities, and improvements.

- Change rent commencement for phase 1 of project to September 5, 2025
- Update agreement to change completion deadlines to commencement deadlines
- Update exhibits to allow for construction of building square footage in accordance with market conditions
