- Support of local nonprofit and governmental organizations to provide shelter, food and supportive services to individuals, families, and migrants who are experiencing, or at risk of experiencing, hunger and/or homelessness.
- Total Funding awarded: \$39.14 million
- Total Funding remaining: \$13.93 million

Shelter and Services Program (SSP)

In Fiscal Year 2024, Congress appropriated \$650,000,000 to provide financial support to non-federal entities providing shelter and related activities to noncitizen migrants following their release from the Department of Homeland Security (DHS).

Total Funding Awarded: \$9.2 million

Total Funding Remaining: \$8.8 million
