**SUMMARY OF REQUEST:** Applicant requests a Special Exception under Section 2.16.050 B (Two or More Nonconforming Lots) to allow to legalize an existing home structure and accessory structure in an R-3 (Residential) zone district.

**SUMMARY OF STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends **APPROVAL** of the special exception request as the requested encroachment is less than/equal to the encroachments into that setback already present on at least two other neighboring properties and have existed for at least fifteen years.

**DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST:** The applicant is requesting a special exception to allow to legalize an existing accessory structure for the swimming pool equipment, which extends 5 feet into their required side yard setback for a total encroachment of 74.51 square feet. Additionally, the applicant is requesting a special exception to allow to legalize the construction of home structure, which extends 2.14 foot into the required side yard setback for a total encroachment of 5.59 square feet.

**BACKGROUND:** The minimum side yard setback is 5 feet in the R-3 (Residential) zone district. Aerial photographs indicate there are two other properties on the same block that also contain structures located in the side yard that encroach into their respective side yard setbacks located at 423 Golden Springs Drive (108 square feet) and 425 Golden Springs Drive (75 square feet).

According to records from the El Paso Central Appraisal District, the current owner has held the property since 1997. The main residence was constructed in 1991; however, the exact date of construction for the accessory structure is unknown. Aerial imagery from 2009 confirms that home structure existed in its current location and condition at that time, indicating the encroachment has been present for over 15 years.

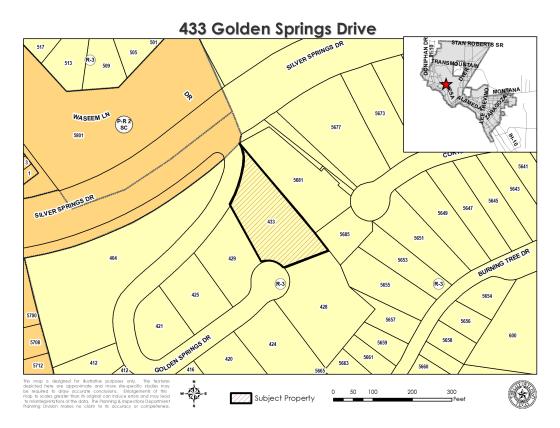

#### **ZONING BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT OPTIONS:**

The purpose of the Zoning Ordinance is to promote the health, safety, morals and general welfare of the City. The Zoning Board of Adjustment (ZBA) has the authority to grant a special exception to the zoning code only as provided in El Paso City Code Titles 2 and 20. In evaluating the request, the ZBA may take any of the following actions:

- Approval of the special exception request, finding that the request is in in harmony with the spirit and purposes of Titles 2 and 20, including the preservation of the essential character of the district in which the property is located, that the public convenience and welfare will be substantially served, and that the use of neighboring property will not be substantially injured. (Staff Recommendation)
- 2. **Approval with Modifications** of the special exception request to bring the request into conformance as provided in El Paso City Code Titles 2 and 20 as the board deems appropriate.
- 3. **Denial** of the special exception request, finding that the request does not conform to the review criteria as provided in El Paso City Code Titles 2 and 20.

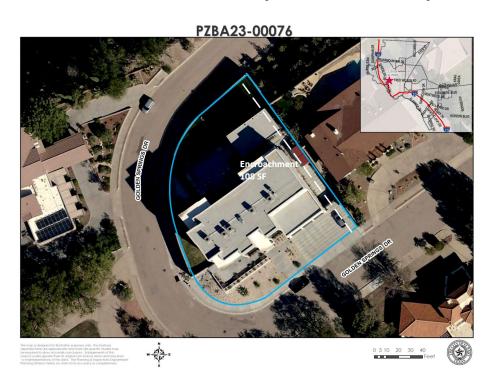

**SUMMARY OF REQUEST:** Applicant requests a Special Exception under Section 2.16.050 B (Two or More Nonconforming Lots) to allow to legalize an existing home addition in an R-5 (Residential) zone district.

**SUMMARY OF STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends **APPROVAL WITH CONDITIONS** of the special exception request as the requested encroachments are less than the encroachments into that setback already present on at least two other neighboring properties. The conditions are as follows:

- 1. That the overhang of the rear addition encroaching into the rear 5-foot utility easement be removed.
- 2. The existing carport encroaching into the southerly side setback shall be modified or removed to comply with the zoning requirements of the El Paso City Code.

**DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST:** The applicant is requesting a special exception to allow to legalize the construction of an existing rear addition, which extends 13.17 feet into the required rear yard setback for 171.21 square feet of encroachment and which extends 2 feet into the northerly side setback for a total encroachment area of 40 square feet.

**BACKGROUND:** The minimum front setback is 10 feet in the R-5 (Residential) zone district. The required rear setback for the subject property is 18.17 feet to meet the cumulative front and rear setback of 45 feet in the R-5 (Residential) zone district. Aerial photographs indicate that there are four (4) nearby properties located on the same block or abutting street that encroach into their respective rear and side setbacks, with encroachments equal to or larger than those on the subject property. These properties are located at 206 Baywood Road (272.45 S.F. side addition encroachment), 214 Baywood Road (208.24 S.F. side addition encroachment), 220 Arbor Place (177 S.F. rear addition encroachment and 139.49 S.F. side addition encroachment) and 222 Arbor Place (275 S.F. rear addition encroachment and 149.56 S.F. side addition encroachment). The property located at 222 Arbor Place was registered as legal nonconforming in 2025 for the rear and side addition encroachments, while the remainder of the aforementioned properties do not have any issued permits on record. The existing carport encroaching into the southerly side setback shall be modified or removed to have a two-foot (2') setback and a five-foot (5') masonry wall along the side property line as required to comply with zoning requirements.

Based on Central Appraisal District records, the single-family dwelling was built in 1958 and the carport and addition encroachments were built in 2021 by the current owner. The request is due to a code enforcement citation that was issued in August of 2024.

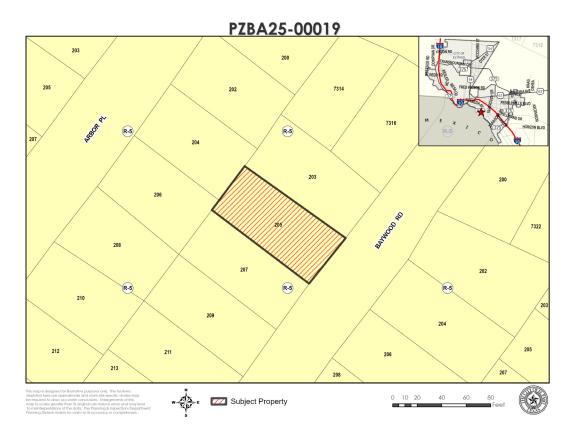

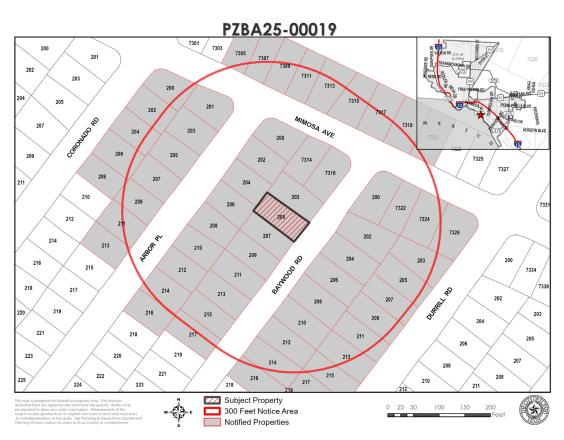

- 2. **Approval with Modifications** of the special exception request to bring the request into conformance as provided in El Paso City Code Titles 2 and 20 as the board deems appropriate. **(Staff Recommendation)**
- 3. **Denial** of the special exception request, finding that the request does not conform to the review criteria as provided in El Paso City Code Titles 2 and 20.

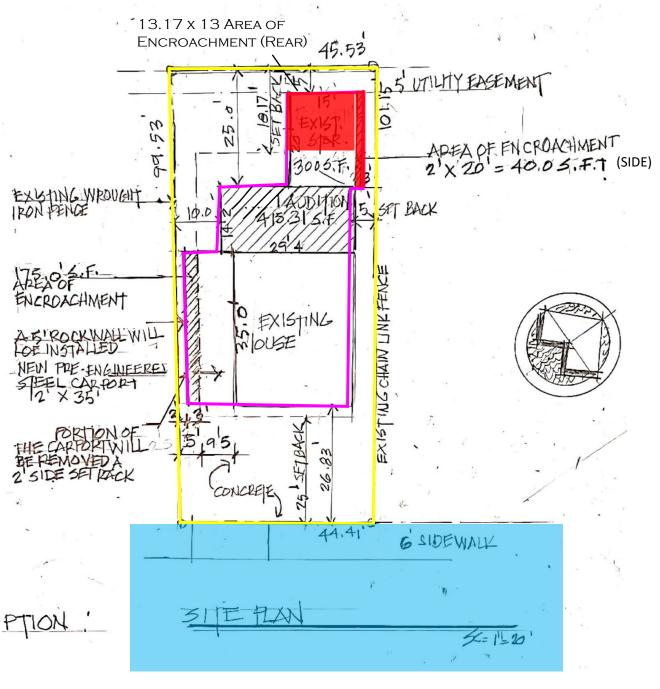
# **ZONING MAP**



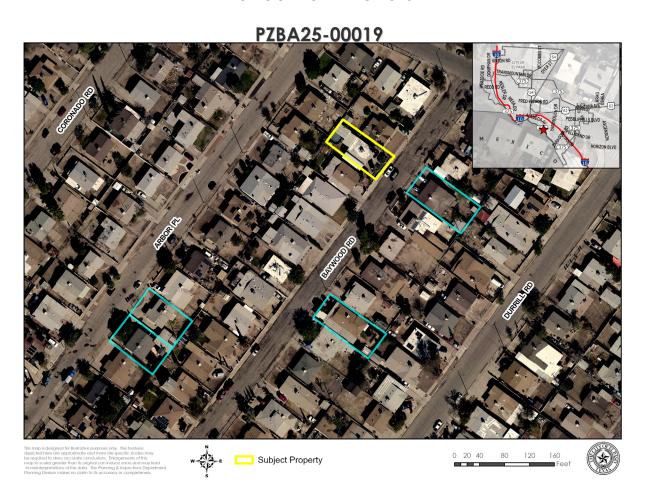
# **NEIGHBORHOOD NOTIFICATION MAP**

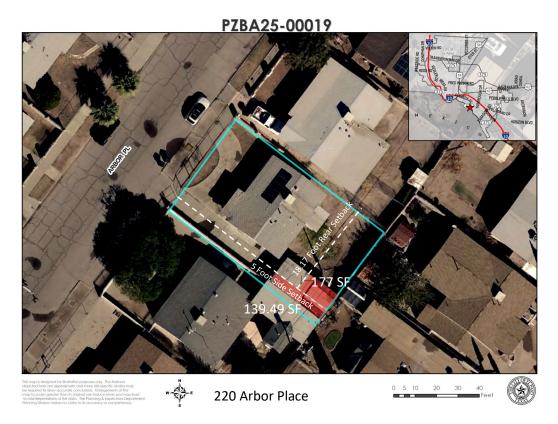

- 2. The carport shall be modified to comply with the side setback requirement.

**DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST:** The applicant is requesting a special exception to allow to legalize the construction of an existing carport of approximately 24 feet by 24 feet and an area of 576 square feet, of which 411.86 square feet encroaches 20.7 feet into the front yard setback and is located to within 4.3 feet of the front property line. The carport shall be modified to comply with the side setback requirement. The applicant is also requesting a special exception to legalize the construction of an existing home, which extends 3.6 feet into the side yard setback and of which 66.08 square feet of that structure encroach into the side yard setback.

**BACKGROUND:** The required front setback for the subject property is 25 feet to meet the cumulative front and rear setback of 60 feet in the R-2 (Residential) zone district. The required side setback for the subject property is 8 feet to meet the cumulative sides setback of 20 feet in the R-2 (Residential) zone district.

The current owner has owned the property since 2014 and the building was constructed in 1968 based on El Paso Central Appraisal District records. The existing home encroachment has been in existence approximately for 57 years. Based on 2009 aerial imagery, the property existed back then as it does today, with the home in its current location.

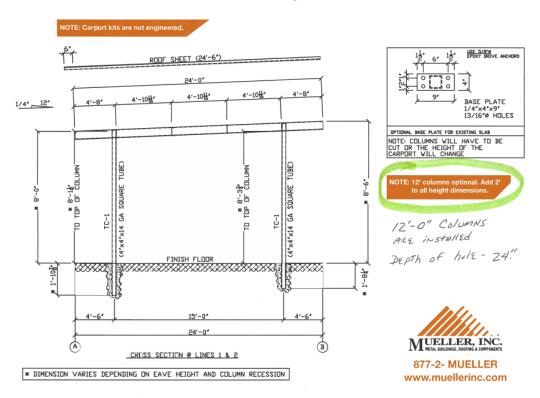

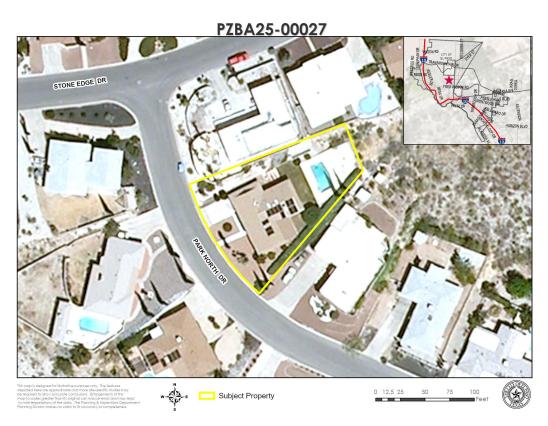

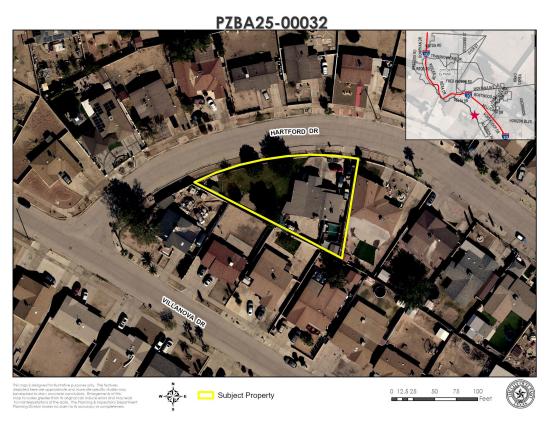


Figure A. Aerial of Subject Property & Immediate Surroundings

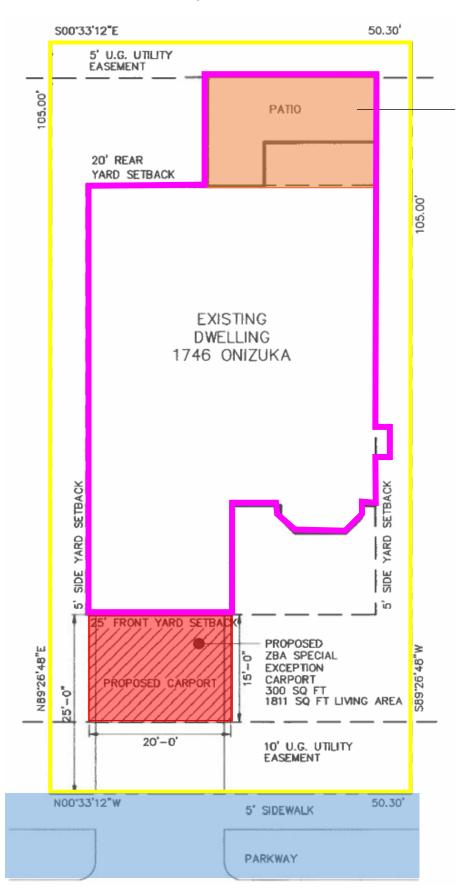

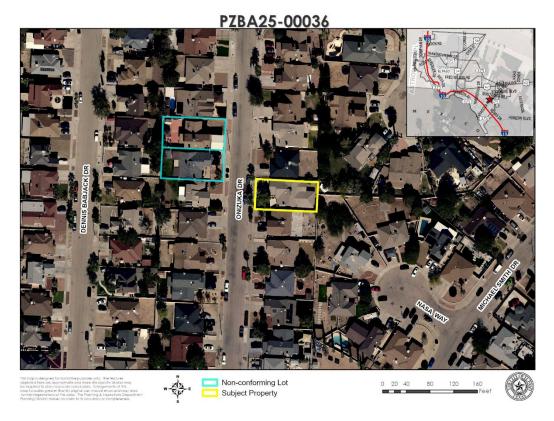

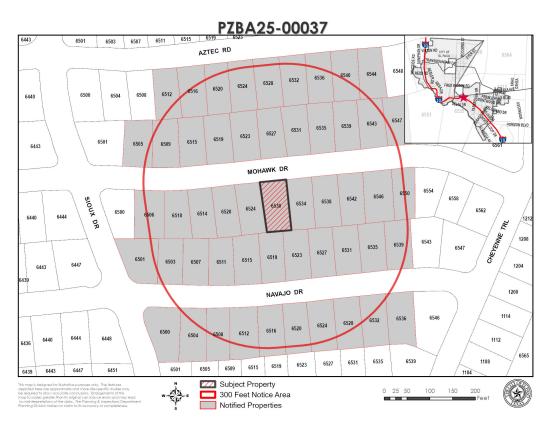

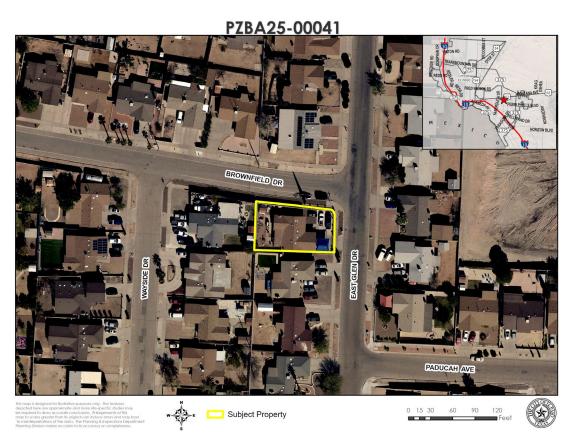


Figure A. Aerial of Subject Property & Immediate Surroundings

**DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST:** The applicant is requesting a special exception to allow to legalize the construction of an existing carport, which extends 15 feet 3 inches into the required front yard setback and 2 feet 6 inches into the required side yard setback for 264.27 square feet of encroachment of the front yard setback and 43.29 square feet of encroachment of the side yard setback.

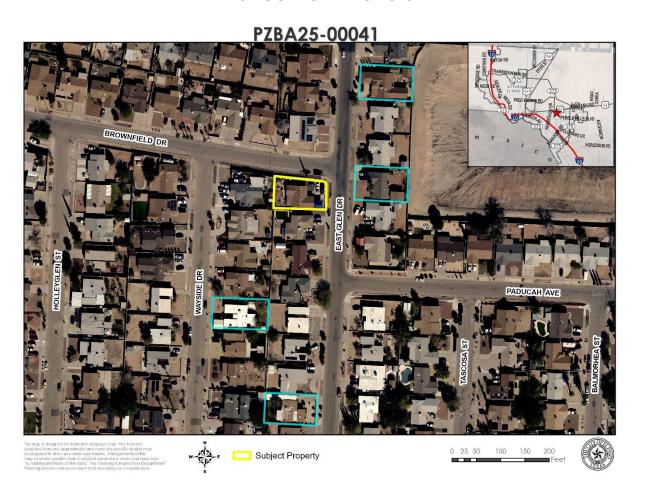

The porch and canopy structures encroach 20 feet into the required rear yard setback, totaling approximately 368 square feet. Two accessory structures encroach 5 feet into the required side yard setback, totaling approximately 72 square feet.

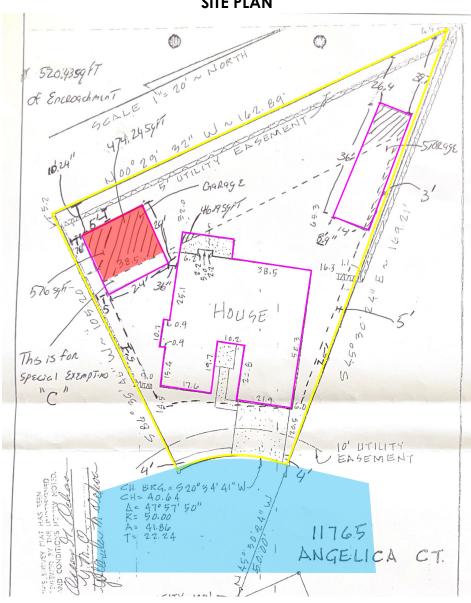

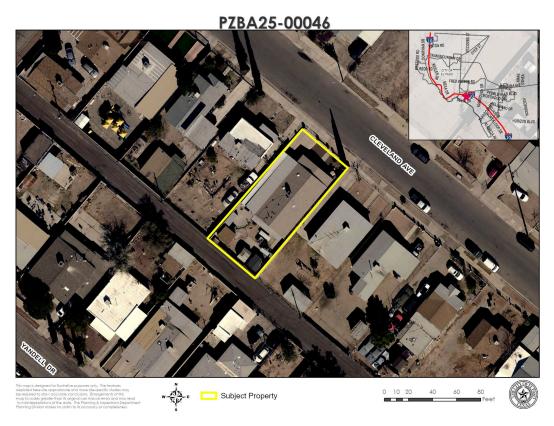


Figure A. Aerial of Subject Property & Immediate Surroundings

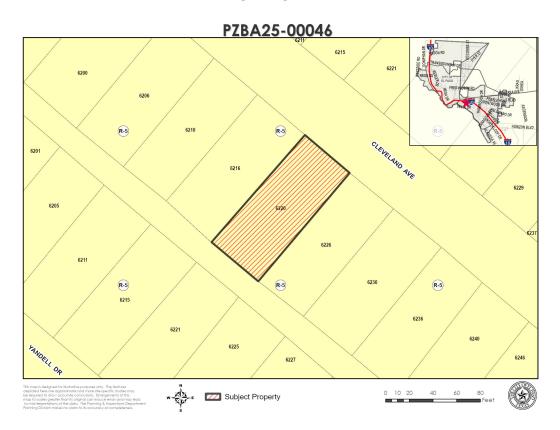

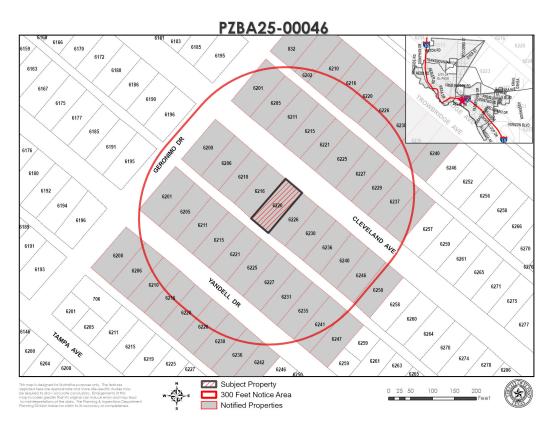

- 1. **Approval** of the special exception request, finding that the request is in in harmony with the spirit and purposes of Titles 2 and 20, including the preservation of the essential character of the district in which the property is located, that the public convenience and welfare will be substantially served, and that the use of neighboring property will not be substantially injured.
- 2. **Approval with Modifications** of the special exception request to bring the request into conformance as provided in El Paso City Code Titles 2 and 20 as the board deems appropriate. **(Staff Recommendation)**
- 3. **Denial** of the special exception request, finding that the request does not conform to the review criteria as provided in El Paso City Code Titles 2 and 20.

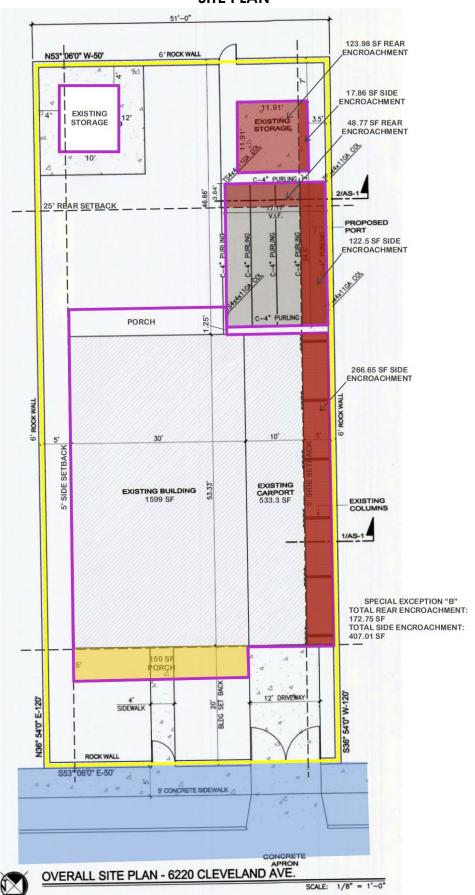

**DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST:** The applicant is requesting a special exception to permit the construction a proposed attached garage to a new single-family dwelling structure which would extend 12 feet 4 inches into the required rear yard setback for 330 square feet of total encroachment.

**BACKGROUND:** The minimum rear setback is 20 feet in the R-3 (Residential) zone district. The required rear setback for the subject property is 20 feet to meet the cumulative front and rear setback of 50 feet in the R-3 (Residential) zone district. Aerial photographs indicate there are three other properties within the same block on the same side of the street that have similar encroachments. These properties are located at 935 Rim Road (759.24 S.F. rear yard encroachment), 925 Rim Road (752.05 S.F. rear yard encroachment) and 901 Rim Road (469.35 S.F. rear yard encroachment). The property located at 925 Rim Road has an issued building permit while the other properties do not have issued permits on record.

The current owner has owned the property since 1978 based on El Paso Central Appraisal District. The previous single-family dwelling structure was demolished in 2024.

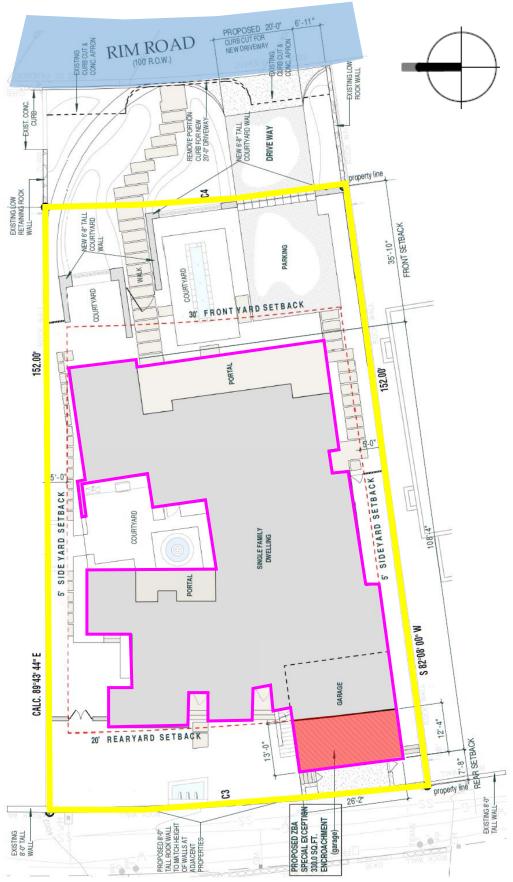

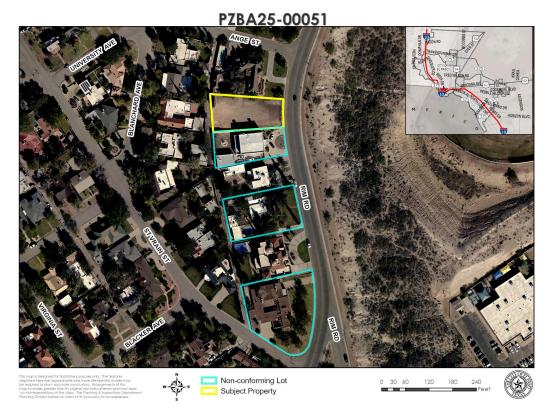

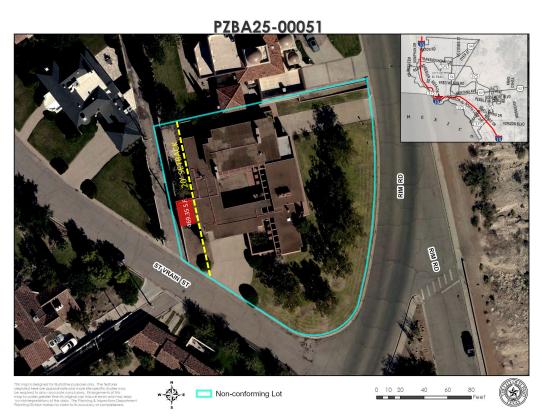
