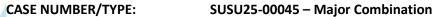

DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST: The applicant is proposing to subdivide 20.26 acres of vacant land to create two (commercial) lots, ranging in in size from 1.62 acres to 17.33 acres. Primary access will be from Joe Battle Blvd and the extension of previously created Poe Court into the subdivision. Drainage flow will be provided by onsite ponding, to be maintained by the applicant. The subdivision was reviewed under the standards of the current Subdivision Code.

CASE HISTORY/RELATED APPLICATIONS: The City Plan Commission recommended approval of Power of Dreams Unit One subdivision December 15, 2022. This subdivision created Poe Court, thereby providing access to Power of Dreams Unit Two through the extension of the roadway cross-section.

Figure A: Proposed plat with surrounding area

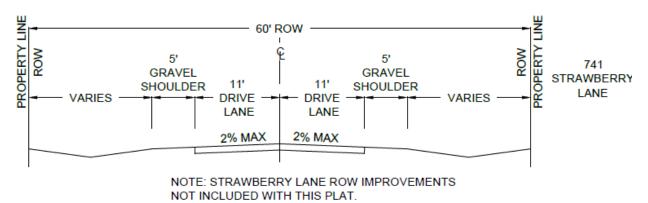

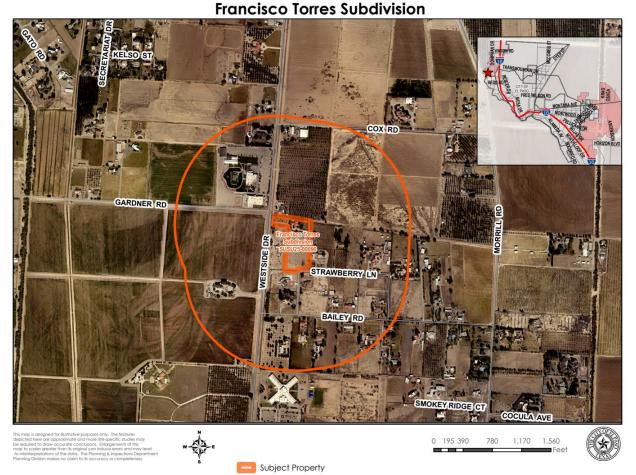


Figure B: Developed properties within a quarter mile of proposed subdivision

FINAL ENGINEER'S REPORT

A drainage investigation was completed for 741 Strawberry Ln. The existing property at this address is 5.666 acres. The Owner's intent is to subdivide to a 3.000 acre lot and 2.666 acre lot. The 3.000 acre is to be strictly non-residential, while the 2.666 acre lot is residential with an existing single family home.

The scope of this drainage study is to examine the ponding required on the two lots. The intent of this report is to analyze the onsite drainage, and provide recommendations to meet the on-site ponding requirements for El Paso County, TX. This report will address all findings obtained during the drainage investigation and identify drainage characteristics pertaining to the project site.

This drainage analysis was completed using the methodology outlined in the "County of El Paso Subdivision Design", dated March 10, 1997. The hydraulic analysis was calculated from the Retention Basin section, D-3, of the "County of El Paso Subdivision Design Standards".

The rainfall provided from the Design Standards is to be 4" within a 3 hour period. The project area is a single family residence with a long driveway entrance. To the west is the 3 acre lot that is to be subdivided as an agricultural field, Lot2. The northern portion of the western property line abuts the La Union East Lateral, and Westside Dr. To the north and east are single family residences with agricultural fields. To the south, is a single family residence and access to Strawberry Ln. The existing driveway is mostly gravel road with portions of concrete parking near the house. Both lots have room for onsite ponding.

Per Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), the project area is located within Flood Zone Designation X. as designated by F.E.M.A.; City of El Paso, Community Panel No. 4802120025B. Construction of residential housing within any area of the subdivision that is in the 100-year floodplain is prohibited unless the housing qualifies for insurance under the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. Sections 4001 through 4127). The FEMA Flood Insurance Rate FIRMette Map is included in Appendix A for the project area.

There are 4 natural basins on this property. The majority of the property is relatively flat, there are site characteristics that help divide the property. Basin 1A is the section of the property west of the house with a natural low area near the center. Basin 1B is east of the house and north of the driveway. The driveway is Basin 1C and contains a long narrow bar ditch approx. 15' from the western edge of the gravel driveway. Basin 2A is an agricultural field with available ponding within the field. With limited grading, each area would be able to hold the volume required for on-site ponding. The design criteria used in this study come from "County of El Paso Subdivision Design".

The retention basin is to be utilized for this property due to the site constraints that make a detention basin difficult. There are limited options to capture the amount of water required and find an easily accessible outfall location.

The existing site carries a slope of 0-1% from Strawberry Ln., to the north property line. There is a section of the northwest corner that slopes 3-5% up to the La Union East Lateral. The table below lists the Total Runoff for the site.

The emergency capacity is 25% of the total runoff. The sum of the total runoff from Table 5-1 is 19,664 cu-ft. There is also a Ten-Year Silt load that needs consideration with a volume 0.012 ac-ft/ac. Table below, lists the Total on site ponding required.

In conclusion, there is available space to capture the required retention volume on-site. I would recommend a retention pond for each existing drainage basin. This will limit the grading to only the additional cut required for the ponds. Please refer to the Post Development Map in the Appendix.

Pond 1, located within Basin 1A would have a design capacity of 10,991 cu-ft. Pond 2, located within Basin 1B would have a design capacity of 9,677 cu-ft. Pond 3, located within Basin 1C would have a design capacity of 5,720 cu-ft. Depressed Area, located within Basin 2A would have a design capacity of 29,567 cu-ft.

This satisfies the required volume for on-site ponding for El Paso County.

WATER FACILITIES

Francisco Torres Plat Lot 1 is provided with potable water by the existing water well on site. The existing water well complies with requirements of 30 TAC 230.1 through 230.11 for individual water supply well and certifies the long term (30 year) quantity and quality of available groundwater supplies relative to the ultimate need of the lot. The water quality meets the standards set forth in 30 TAC 290.104, 290.106, 290.108 and 290.109 without treatment identified.

Francisco Torres Plat Lot 2: No water facilities provided with this plat.

SEWER FACILITIES

Francisco Torres Plat Lot 1 is treated by on-site sewer facilities ("OSSF" or "Septic System"). Lot 1 has an existing septic system. The existing septic system on Lot 1 complies with 30 TAC Chapter 285. Refer to "El Paso City-Council Health and Environmental District License No. 93-864 Dated November 8, 1993. 1250 gallon tank, 780 square feet drainfield, private well."

Se llevo a cabo una investigación de drenaje para 741 Strawberry Ln. La propiedad en esta dirección tiene 5.666 acres. La intención del propietario es subdividirla en un lote de 3.000 acres y un lote de 2.666 acres. El lote de 3.000 acres no debe ser residencial, mientras que el lote de 2.666 acres es residencial con una casa unifamiliar.

El alcance de este estudio de drenaje es examinar el encharcamiento requerido en los dos lotes. La intención de este informe es analizar el drenaje en el sitio y brindar recomendaciones para cumplir con los requisitos de encharcamiento en el sitio para el condado de El Paso, TX. Este informe abordará todos los hallazgos obtenidos durante la investigación de drenaje e identificará las características de drenaje relacionadas con el sitio del proyecto.

Este análisis de drenaje se realizó utilizando la metodología descrita en el "Diseño de la subdivisión del condado de El Paso", con fecha del 10 de marzo de 1997. El análisis hidráulico se calculó a partir de la sección de cuenca de retención, D-3, de las "Normas de diseño de la subdivisión del condado de

La lluvia prevista en las normas de diseño debe ser de 4" en un período de 3 horas. El área del proyecto es una residencia unifamiliar con una entrada vehicular larga. Al oeste se encuentra el lote de 3 acres que se subdividirá como campo agrícola, Lote 2. La parte norte de la línea de propiedad occidental colinda con La Union East Lateral y Westside Dr. Al norte y al este hay residencias unifamiliares con campos agrícolas. Al sur, hay una residencia unifamiliar y acceso a Strawberry Ln. La entrada vehicular que existente es principalmente un camino de grava con partes de estacionamiento de concreto cerca de la casa. Ambos lotes tienen espacio para un estanque en el lugar.

Según la Agencia Federal para el Manejo de Emergencias (FEMA), el área del proyecto se encuentra dentro de la Designación de Zona de Inundación X, según lo designado por FEMA; Ciudad de El Paso, Panel Comunitario N.º 4802120025B. La construcción de viviendas residenciales dentro de cualquier área de la subdivisión que se encuentre en la llanura aluvial de 100 años está prohibida a menos que la vivienda califique para el seguro según la Ley Nacional de Seguros contra Inundaciones de 1968 (42 U.S.C. Secciones 4001 a 4127). El Mapa FIRMette de Tasas de Seguros contra Inundaciones de FEMA está incluido en el Apéndice A para el área del proyecto.

Hay 4 cuencas naturales en esta propiedad. La mayor parte de la propiedad es relativamente plana, hay características del sitio que ayudan a dividir la propiedad. La cuenca 1A es la sección de la propiedad al oeste de la casa con un área baja natural cerca del centro. La cuenca 1B está al este de la casa y al norte del camino de entrada. El camino de entrada es la cuenca 1C y contiene una zanja de barra larga y angosta de aproximadamente 15 pies del borde occidental del camino de grava. La cuenca 2A es un campo agrícola con estanque disponible dentro del campo. Cada área podría contener el volumen requerido para el estanque en el sitio, con una nivelación limitada. Los criterios de diseño utilizados en este estudio provienen del "Diseño de subdivisión del condado de El Paso".

La cuenca de retención se utilizará para esta propiedad debido a las limitaciones del sitio que dificultan una cuenca de retención. Hay opciones limitadas para capturar la cantidad de agua requerida y encontrar una ubicación de descarga de fácil acceso.

El sitio existente tiene una inclinación de 0-1% desde Strawberry Ln., hasta la línea norte de propiedad. Hay una sección de la esquina noroeste que tiene una inclinación de 3-5% hasta el lateral este de La Union. La siguiente tabla enumera la escorrentía total para el sitio.

En conclusión, hay espacio disponible para capturar el volumen de retención requerido en el sitio. Recomendaría un estanque de retención para cada cuenca de drenaje que existe. DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST: The applicant requests to rezone the subject property from C-3 (Commercial) to R-3A (Residential) for proposed development of a school. The property is approximately 1.97 acres in size and the conceptual site plan illustrates the subject property being part of a larger development proposed for a middle school with athletic facilities. The site plan is not binding and is not being reviewed for compliance with El Paso City Code. The subject property has access to Resler Drive and Cimarron Canyon Drive.

PREVIOUS CASE HISTORY: City Council approved a rezoning in January 20, 2004 for a large area of land 2 via Ordinance No. 15672 (attachment 3). The subject property is located within Parcel 1 and Parcel 2, with Parcel 1 having been were rezoned from R-3 (Residential) to C-1 (Commercial) and Parcel 2 having been rezoned from R-3 (Residential) to C-3/c (Commercial/conditions). On November 7, 2023, City Council amended the imposed conditions via Ordinance No. 19555 (attachment 5) to the following:

The portion of Parcel 1 that will remain commercial zoned shall provide a ten-foot (10') landscaped buffer with high-profile native or naturalized trees of at least two-inch (2") caliper and ten feet (10') in height shall be placed at twenty feet (20') on center along the property lines adjacent to residential zone districts or uses. The landscaped buffer shall be irrigated and maintained by the property owner at all times and shall be installed prior to the issuance of any certificates of occupancy or certificates of completion. No landscape buffer shall be required where adjacent to stormwater ponding or open space areas.

In addition, City Council approved a rezoning in November 7, 2023 for a larger area of land, with the northern portion of the subject property located within Parcel 1, which was rezoned from C-1 (Commercial) to C-3/c (Commercial/conditions). The following condition was imposed on Parcel 1 via Ordinance No. 19554 (attachment 4):

That a ten-foot (10') landscaped buffer with high-profile native or naturalized trees of at least two-inch (2") caliper and ten feet (10') in height shall be placed at twenty feet (20') on center along the property lines adjacent to residential zone districts or uses. The landscaped buffer shall be irrigated and maintained by the property owner at all times and shall be installed prior to the issuance of any certificates of occupancy or certificates of completion. No landscape buffer shall be required where adjacent to stormwater ponding or open space areas.

COMPATIBILITY WITH NEIGHBORHOOD CHARACTER: The proposed rezoning request and use is compatible with neighboring properties and zoning districts. Furthermore, the property is proposed to be part of a larger development under the same R-3A (Residential) zoning district. PUBLIC COMMENT: The subject property does not lie within the boundaries of any neighborhood association. Public notice was sent to all property owners within 300 feet of the subject property on November 21, 2025. As of November 26, 2025, the Planning Division has received one call of inquiry and one call of opposition to the rezoning and condition release request. The reasoning for the opposition was increased traffic, limited access, and safety concerns with the proposed development.

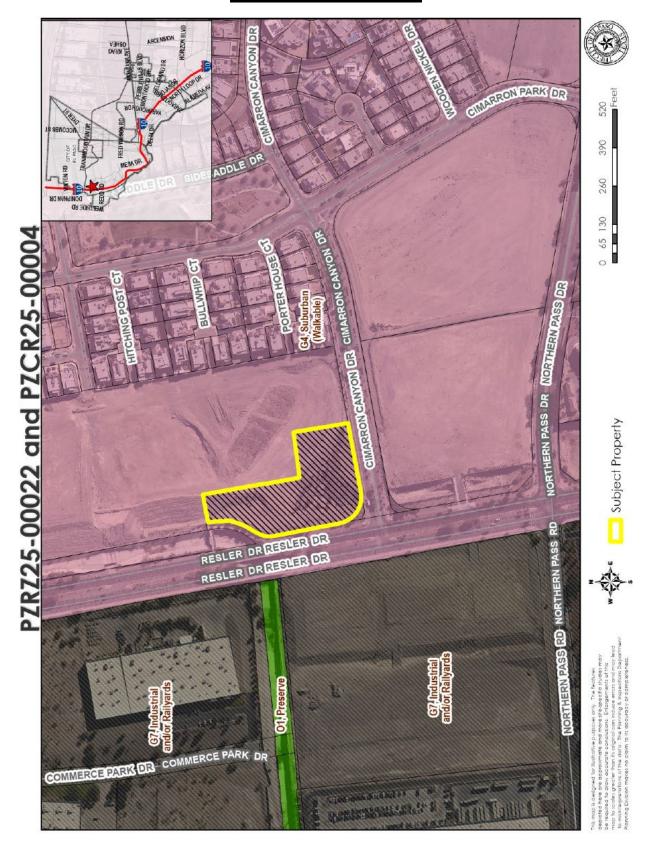
RELATED APPLICATIONS: There is a condition release application (PZCR25-00004) running concurrently with the rezoning request to release all imposed conditions on the subject property.

DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST: The applicant requests to release all conditions imposed by Ordinance No. 15672, Ordinance No. 19554, and Ordinance No. 19555 for proposed development of a school. The conditions being released are no longer applicable and not necessary.

PREVIOUS CASE HISTORY: City Council approved a rezoning in January 20, 2004 for a large area of land 2 via Ordinance No. 15672 (attachment 3). The subject property is located within Parcel 1 and Parcel 2, with Parcel 1 having been were rezoned from R-3 (Residential) to C-1 (Commercial) and Parcel 2 having been rezoned from R-3 (Residential) to C-3/c (Commercial/conditions). On November 7, 2023, City Council amended the imposed conditions via Ordinance No. 19555 (attachment 5) to the following:

The portion of Parcel 1 that will remain commercial zoned shall provide a ten-foot (10') landscaped buffer with high-profile native or naturalized trees of at least two-inch (2") caliper and ten feet (10') in height shall be placed at twenty feet (20') on center along the property lines adjacent to residential zone districts or uses. The landscaped buffer shall be irrigated and maintained by the property owner at all times and shall be installed prior to the issuance of any certificates of occupancy or certificates of completion. No landscape buffer shall be required where adjacent to stormwater ponding or open space areas.

In addition, City Council approved a rezoning in November 7, 2023 for a larger area of land, with the northern portion of the subject property located within Parcel 1, which was rezoned from C-1 (Commercial) to C-3/c (Commercial/conditions). The following condition was imposed on Parcel 1 via Ordinance No. 19554 (attachment 4):

That a ten-foot (10') landscaped buffer with high-profile native or naturalized trees of at least two-inch (2") caliper and ten feet (10') in height shall be placed at twenty feet (20') on center along the property lines adjacent to residential zone districts or uses. The landscaped buffer shall be irrigated and maintained by the property owner at all times and shall be installed prior to the issuance of any certificates of occupancy or certificates of completion. No landscape buffer shall be required where adjacent to stormwater ponding or open space areas.

STAFF ANALYSIS: Conditions on the property were imposed to protect adjacent residential uses from commercial uses that would be permitted on the subject property. Conditions involved a landscape buffer, which would act to setback any construction, as well as act as screening between such developments. The subject property is concurrently going through a rezoning from C-3 (Commercial) to R-3A (Residential). If the rezoning is approved, the subject property will match the adjacent residential property to the north and east. Due to this, the conditions would no longer be necessary and staff recommends their release.

COMPATIBILITY WITH NEIGHBORHOOD CHARACTER: The proposed conditions release request and concurrently rezoning request is compatible with neighboring properties and zoning districts. Furthermore, the property is proposed to be part of a larger development under the same R-3A (Residential) zoning district. Land immediately abutting the property to the north and east is currently vacant zoned R-3A (Residential). To the south across Cimarron Canyon Drive, land is currently vacant zoned C-3/c (Commercial/conditions). To the west across Resler Drive, land is currently vacant zoned M-1/sc (Light Manufacturing/special contract). ADEQUACY OF PUBLIC FACILITIES, SERVICES AND INFRASTRUCTURE: The subject property takes access from both Resler Drive and Cimarron Canyon Drive, designated as a major arterial and a local road, respectively as classified in the City's Major Thoroughfare Plan (MTP) and is appropriate to serve the proposed development. There is as sidewalk present along Cimarron Canyon Drive and a shared-use path along Resler Drive. There are no public transportation routes or facilities within walking distance (0.25 mile). Public transportation facilities are found 0.41 miles away from the subject property along Northern Pass Road near Northwestern Drive.

SUMMARY OF DEPARTMENTAL REVIEW COMMENTS: No adverse comments were received from reviewing departments.

PUBLIC COMMENT: The subject property does not lie within the boundaries of any neighborhood association. Public notice was sent to all property owners within 300 feet of the subject property on November 21, 2025. As of November 26, 2025, the Planning Division has received one call of inquiry and one call of opposition to the rezoning and condition release request. The reasoning for the opposition was increased traffic, limited access, and safety concerns with the proposed development.

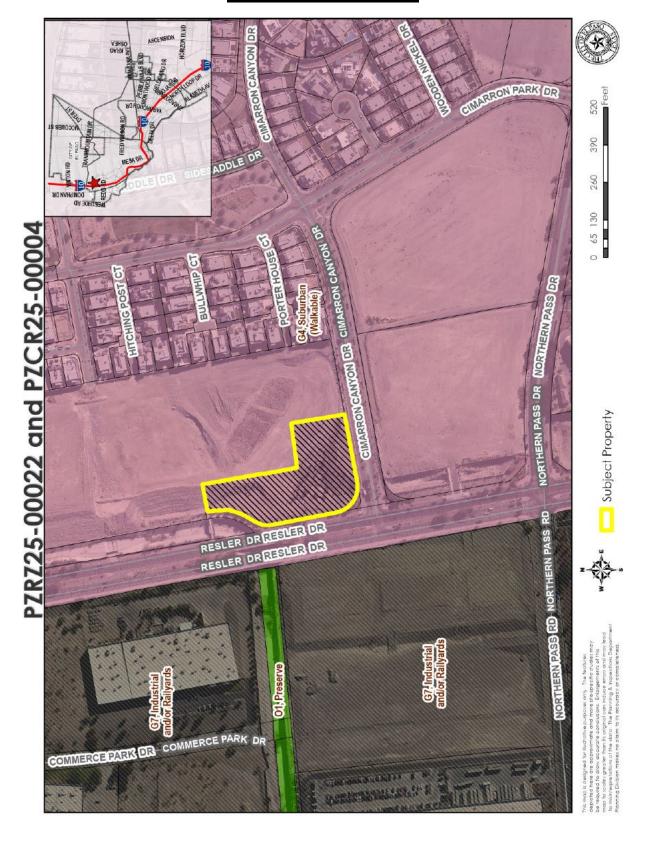

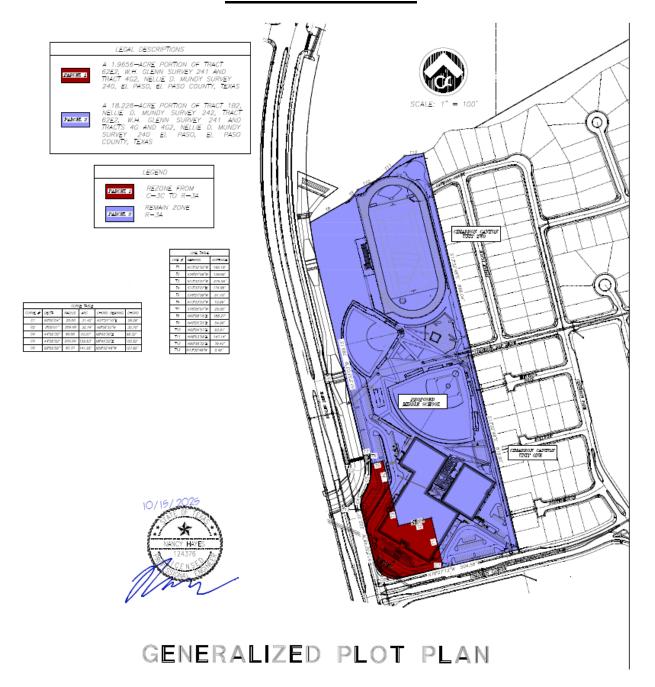

2. For lots within subdivision plats meeting the density requirements of Condition No. 1, the minimum front yard setback shall be at least twenty-five (25) feet.

The land area within these parcels shall not exceed the gross density of the R-3 (Residential) zoning district.

These conditions shall run with the land, are a charge and servitude thereon, and bind the current property owner and any successors in title. The City may enforce these conditions by injunction, by rescission of the zoning which is made appropriate as a result of these conditions, or by any other legal or equitable remedy. The City Council of the City of El Paso may amend or release the above conditions in its discretion without the consent of any third person who may be benefited thereby, and without affecting the validity of this Ordinance.

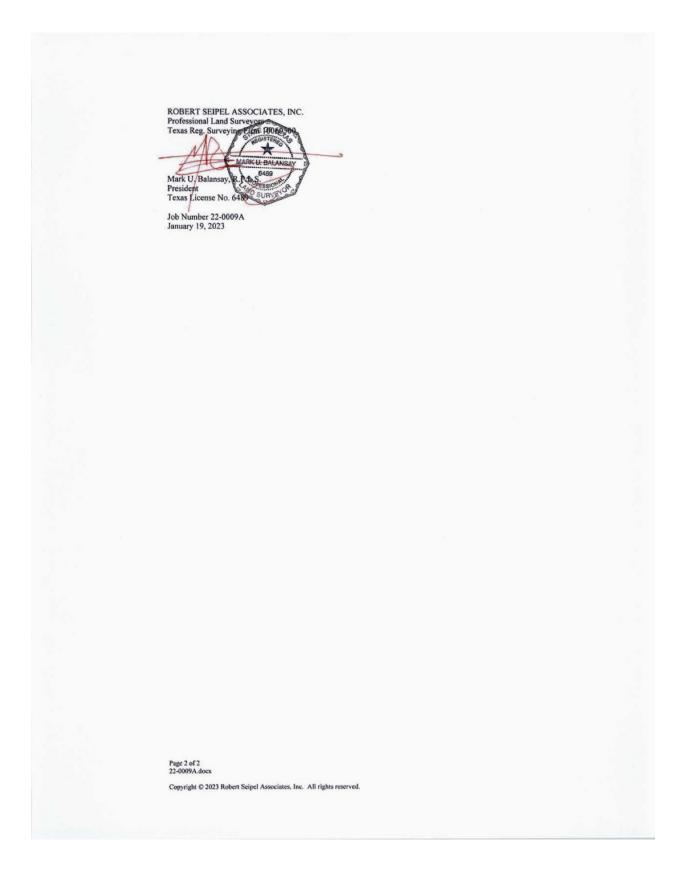

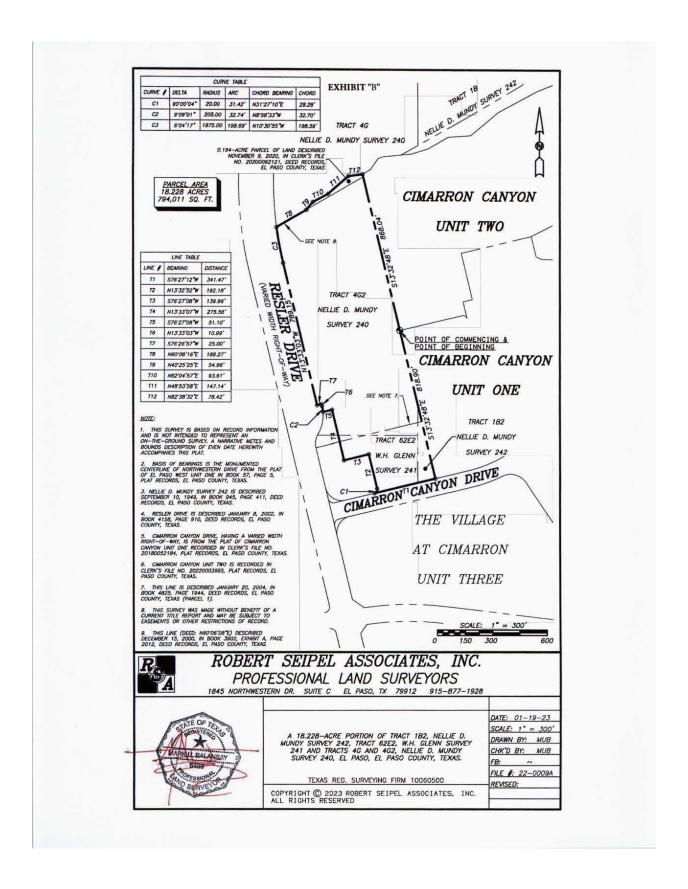

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A CONDITION PLACED ON PARCEL 1 BY ORDINANCE NO. 15672 WHICH CHANGED THE ZONING OF A 4.32-ACRE PORTION OF TRACT 1B2, NELLIE D. MUNDY SURVEY 242, TRACT 62E2, W.H. GLENN SURVEY 241 AND TRACT 4G2, NELLIE D. MUNDY SURVEY 240, CITY OF EL PASO, EL PASO COUNTY, TEXAS, AND WHICH IMPOSED A CONDITION, AND RELEASING ALL CONDITIONS PLACED ON PARCEL 2 BY ORDINANCE NO. 15708 WHICH CHANGED THE ZONING OF A 0.194-ACRE PORTION OF TRACT 4G, NELLIE D. MUNDY SURVEY 240, CITY OF EL PASO, EL PASO COUNTY, TEXAS, AND WHICH IMPOSED A CONDITION. THE PENALTY IS AS PROVIDED FOR IN CHAPTER 20.24 OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE.

WHEREAS, the zoning of Parcel 1 described as a 4.232-acre portion of Tract 1B2, Nellie D. Mundy Survey 242, Tract 62E2, W.H. Glenn Survey 241 and Tract 4G2, Nellie D. Mundy Survey 240, City of El Paso, El Paso County, Texas, was changed by Ordinance No. 15672 approved by City Council on January 20, 2004; and,

WHEREAS, the zoning of Parcel 2 described as a 0.194-acre portion of Tract 4G, Nellie D. Mundy Survey 240, City of El Paso, El Paso County, Texas, was changed by Ordinance No. 15708 approved by City Council on March 2, 2004; and,

WHEREAS, placement of such conditions was necessitated by and attributable to the increased intensity of use generated by the change of zoning; and,

WHEREAS, the owner (applicant) submitted an application requesting a condition amendment and the removal of all conditions because these conditions have been satisfied or are current requirement of the City Code; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing regarding removal of the conditions was held before the City Plan Commission, and the Commission recommended approval of the release of all conditions and approval of the amendment; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso has determined that the release and amendment of certain conditions will protect the best interest, health, safety, and welfare of the public in general.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO, TEXAS:

 That all of the zoning conditions imposed by Ordinance No. 15672 approved by City Council on January 20, 2004, on Parcel 1 identified in Exhibit "A" be amended to read as follows:

Zoning Case No: PZCR23-00002

The portion of Parcel 1 that will remain commercial zoned shall provide a ten-foot (10') landscaped buffer with high-profile native or naturalized trees of at least two-inch (2") caliper and ten feet (10') in height shall be placed at twenty feet (20') on center along the property lines adjacent to residential zone districts or uses. The landscaped buffer shall be irrigated and maintained by the property owner at all times and shall be installed prior to the issuance of any certificates of occupancy or certificates of completion. No landscape buffer shall be required where adjacent to stormwater ponding or open space areas; and,

 That all of the zoning conditions imposed by Ordinance No. 15708 approved by City Council on March 2, 2004, on Parcel 2 identified in Exhibit "B" be released because the conditions have been satisfied and are no longer necessary, or are current requirements of the City Code.

Conditions as follows:

A ten (10) foot wide landscaped buffer to include, but not limited to, evergreen trees placed at fifteen (15) feet on center shall be required along any property line abutting residential or apartment zoning districts, except where abutting el paso natural gas company right of -way, or a twenty-five (25) foot setback shall be required where abutting residential or apartment zoning districts. This shall be in addition to the landscaping requirements of the chapter 20.65 of the El Paso City Code and shall be required prior to the issuance of any building permits.

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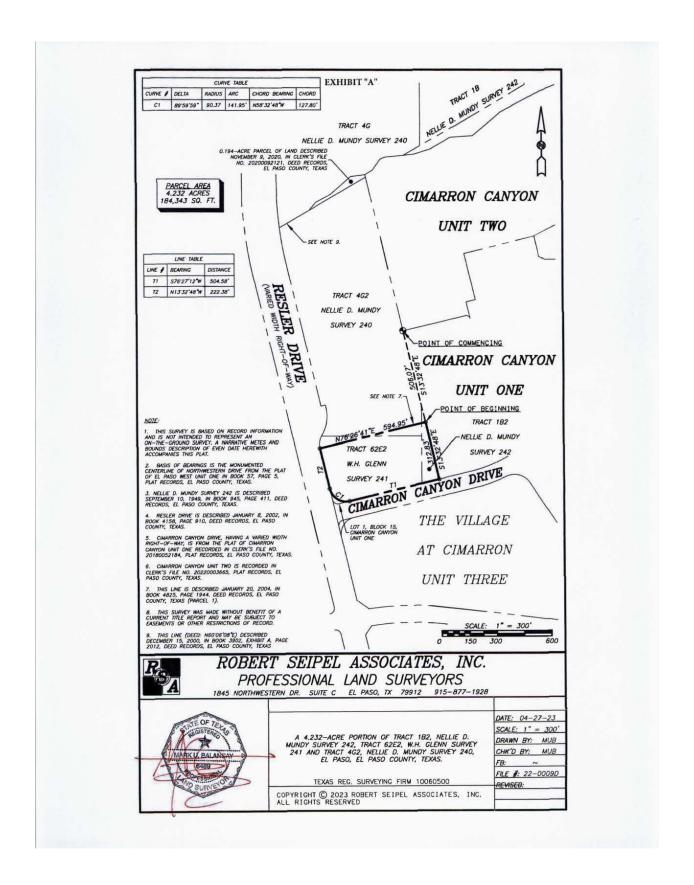

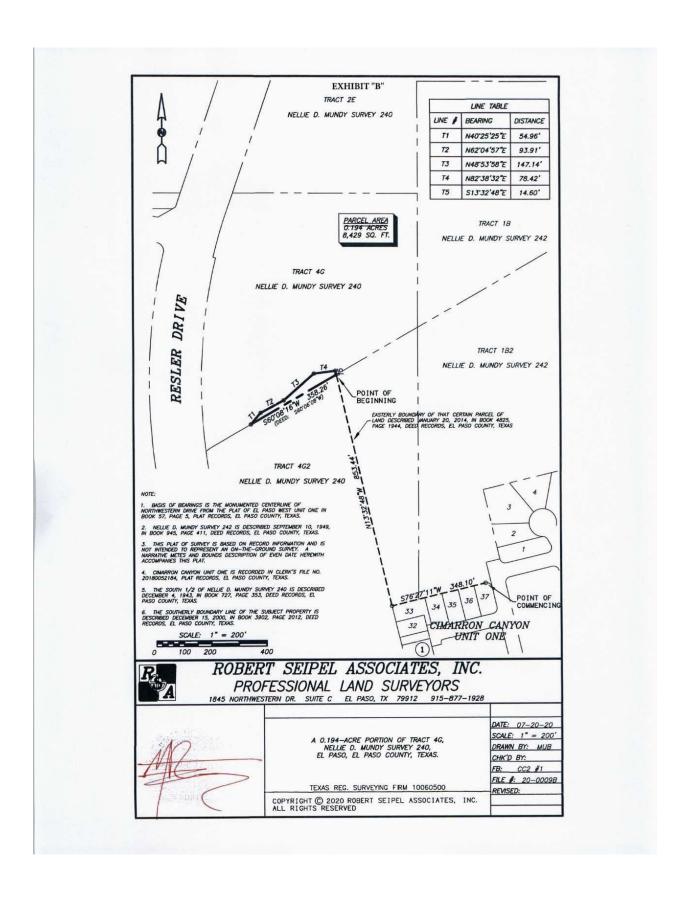

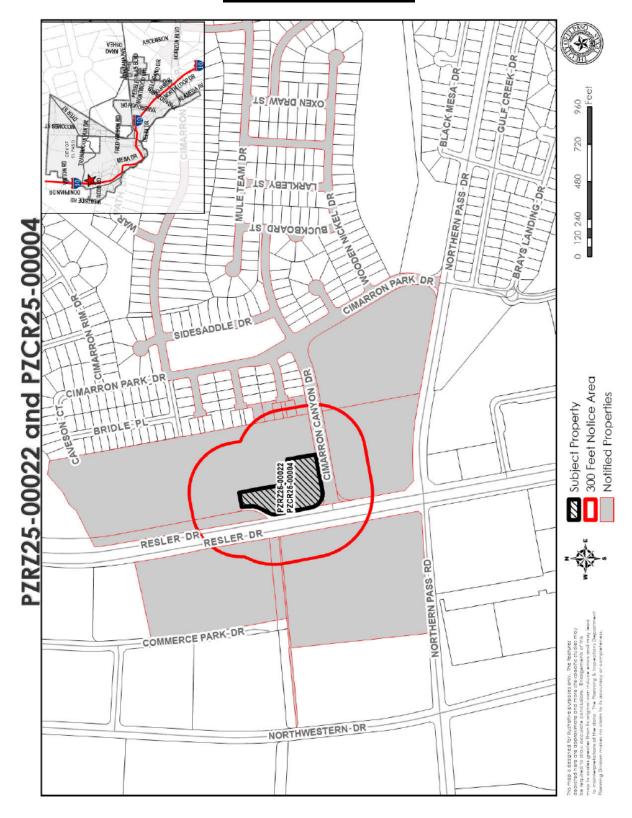
