- Established in 1985
- Highlights the dedication of Parks & Rec Professionals
- 160,000 full-time Parks and Rec professionals in the United States
- The U.S House of Representatives passed an official resolution for Parks and Recreation Month in 2009
- Parks and Recreation agencies nationwide are recognizing the month of July with programming.





#### Facts

- 276 million people in the United States visited a local park or recreation facility at least once during the past year (NRPA, 2025).
- More than 7 in 10 U.S residents have at least one local park, playground, open space, or recreation center within walking distance of their homes (NRPA, 2025).
- 81% of adults seek high-quality parks and recreation when looking for a place to live.
- 91% agree that parks and recreation are an important service provided by their local government.
