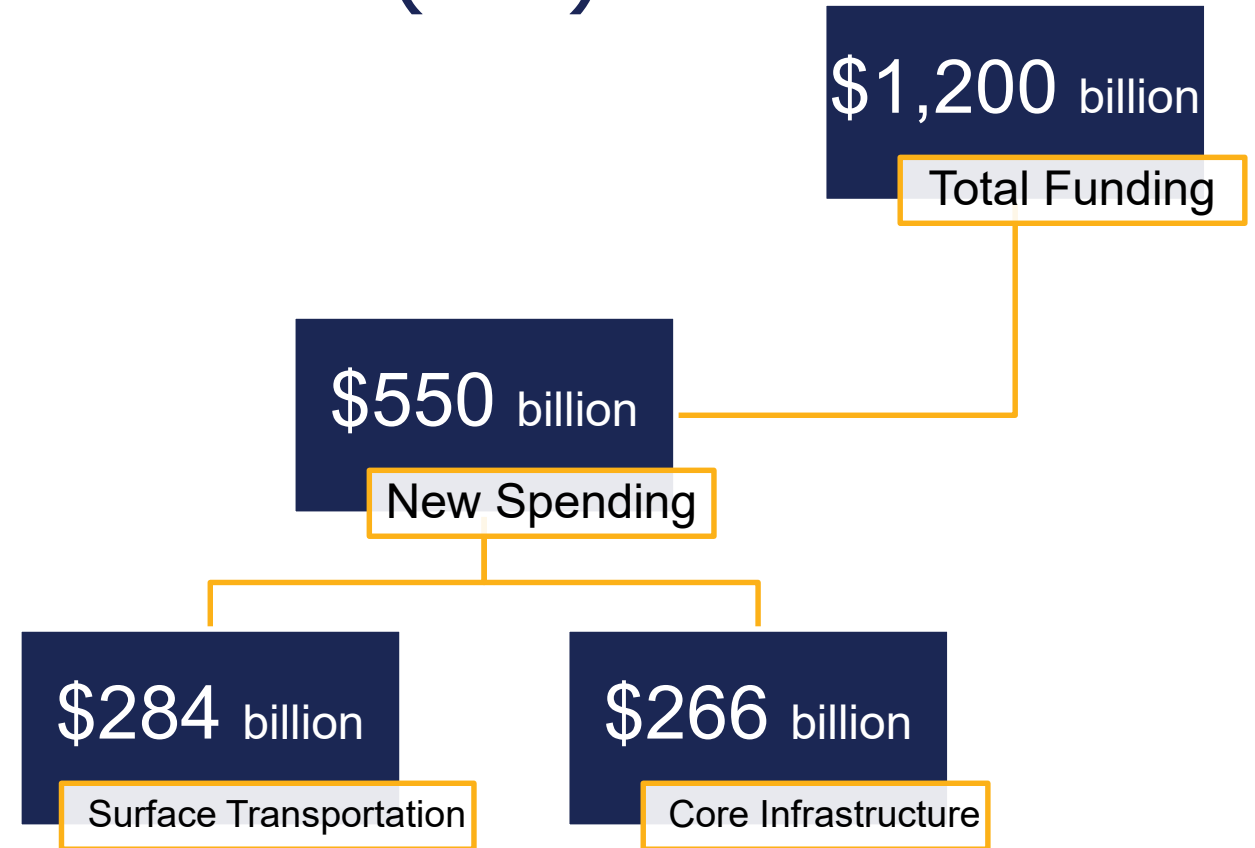

# Upcoming Opportunities: The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL)

- Department of Transportation will direct the largest portion of the BIL's investments (\$274 billion)
- Several other agencies will see their budgets expand
- Investments will go to 5 main areas:
  - Agency Programs + Operations
  - Formula Grants
  - **Competitive Grants** (>\$200 billion)
  - Loans
  - Highway Trust Fund

# MOU Terms

---



**Collaboration between City of El Paso and Paso del Norte Community Foundation to secure grant funds for the development of trails, corridor improvements, transportation, civic spaces, and public facilities.**

- Term: 2 years
- Not to exceed \$260,000
- City will reimburse PDN for costs and provide cooperation in-kind
- Reimbursement requests will be accompanied by reports
- Work plans to be approved by City Manager or designee

**PDN's work includes:**

- Developing a strategy to apply for grant opportunities
  - Plan and write grant applications
  - Public engagement for grant projects

# Requested Action

---

Authorize the City Manager to sign a **Memorandum of Understanding** between the City and **Paso del Norte Community Foundation** to collaborate on securing grant opportunities related to trails, corridor improvements, transportation, civic spaces, and public facilities, wherein PdN will coordinate public outreach, including writing certain grant proposals, and the City will reimburse costs in an amount not to exceed \$260,000.00 over the two year term of this Memorandum of Understanding.
