

Texas A&M Transportation Institute (TTI) Agreement

June 24, 2025



Background

- The Texas Transportation Institute is a state agency that provides transportation studies, research, evaluations and other services related to transportation throughout the State of Texas.
- Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code provides that any one or more public entities may contract with each other for the performance of governmental functions or services in which the contracting parties are mutually interested.
- The City and Sun Metro are required to provide transportation studies and analyses when seeking outside funding for transportation related projects, which may be provided by the Texas Transportation Institute.

11/02/15 – 5 yr Agreement

9/16/08 – 3 yr Agreement

Recommendations

- That the City Manager be authorized to sign a **Master Interlocal Cooperation Agreement** for transportation studies, research, evaluations, and other services by and between the City of El Paso (“City”), a home rule municipal corporation and the Texas A&M Transportation Institute (TTI”), an agency of the State of Texas and a part of the Texas A&M University System.
