AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 2 (ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL), CHAPTER 2.08 (CITY PLAN COMMISSION) TO ADD SECTION 2.08.160 (CLIMATE AND SUSTAINABILITY) IN ORDER TO MODIFY THE PURVIEW OF CITY PLAN COMMISSION TO INCLUDE CLIMATE AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, the El Paso City Council establishes City Boards and Commissions to inform City Council under statutory authorization or on particular issues or subjects of interest to the Council; and

**WHEREAS,** on May 12, 2025, City Council adopted a plan to consolidate and streamline the City's Boards and Commissions; and

WHEREAS, as a result of this plan the Regional Renewable Advisory Committee is dissolved and its purview over climate and sustainable development is moved to the City Plan Commission

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

**SECTION 1**. That El Paso City Code Title 2 (Administration and Personnel), Chapter 2.08 (City Plan Commission, is hereby amended to include Section 2.08.160 (Climate and Sustainability) as follows:

2.08.160 -Climate and Sustainability

The commission shall advise the city council on matters relating to climate and environmental sustainability, including strategies to enhance the City's resilience, reduce emissions, and promote sustainable development.

**SECTION 2.** Except as expressly herein amended, all other provisions of the El Paso City Code will remain in full force and effect
