## Program Focus

- ▶ Speed Cushions
- ▶ Small-Scale Pavement Markings
- ▶ Speed Feedback Signs  
*(Collector streets)*

# Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP)



## Pre-Qualifications

- ▶ Paved street within City Limits
- ▶ Local or Collector street
- ▶ One travel lane of traffic in each direction
- ▶ Speed limit between 20 to 35 MPH
- ▶ Primarily composed of single-family or duplexes housing



## Eligibility Criteria

- ▶ **Petition of Support** – At least 51% residential household signatures from subject street
- ▶ **Traffic Volume** – 500 to 7,500 vehicles per day
- ▶ **Traffic Speed** – 10% of traffic volume traveling 5 MPH or more over the speed limit (*90<sup>th</sup> percentile*)


## General Funds

## Fund Usage

- ▶ Purchase materials (*speed cushions, hardware, power drills, concrete for sign installs, etc..*)
- ▶ On-call consultants for traffic studies (*FY21-23*)






By District

# Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP)



## Prioritization

- Projects are prioritized in the order of application submittal and qualified for the program
- ▶ 1 to 2 years for installation from eligible notice
  - ▶ Projects assigned to Operations by area corrals for installation



## Traffic Impact

- Per After-Studies
- ▶ **27%** Average Traffic Volume Reduction
  - ▶ **25%** Average Speed Reduction (*85<sup>th</sup> percentile speed*)



# Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP)

## Annual General Funds

*Installed eligible applications in queue (FY18 or earlier)*

*Applied new 2022 criteria to all applications in review since start of pandemic*

## Revised NTMP criteria


*Lowered petition and speed criteria*

*Removed additional consensus for speed cushion locations*

## OVERALL:

**Average 54 application per year**

**33% Eligible**

## Moving Forward

- ▶ Create a *MONDAY.COM* dashboard – *Project and application status updates*
- ▶ Staff proposal to revise program criteria
  - **Lower volume criteria** – *Between 500 to 5,000 vehicles per day to comply with speed cushion product warranty*
  - **Remove street classification** – *Include arterials if street meets ALL other NTMP pre-qualifications*
