Solar for All - EPA



Solar for All program is a program that ensures low-income households have access to residential rooftop and residential-serving community solar energy, often through providing financial support and other incentives.

- Total funding available: \$7 Billion (Maximum Opportunity for our Region is \$100 Million).
- Our proposal: Multi-state. EPE's Texas and NM territory.
- Number of awards: up to 35.

What Wins with the EPA...



- 1. ensure low-income households have equitable (increased) access to residential rooftop and residential community solar power
- 2. low-income households receive the benefits including household savings, community ownership, energy resiliency, and other identified benefits.
- 3. minimum 20% total electricity bill savings for households benefiting from the program
