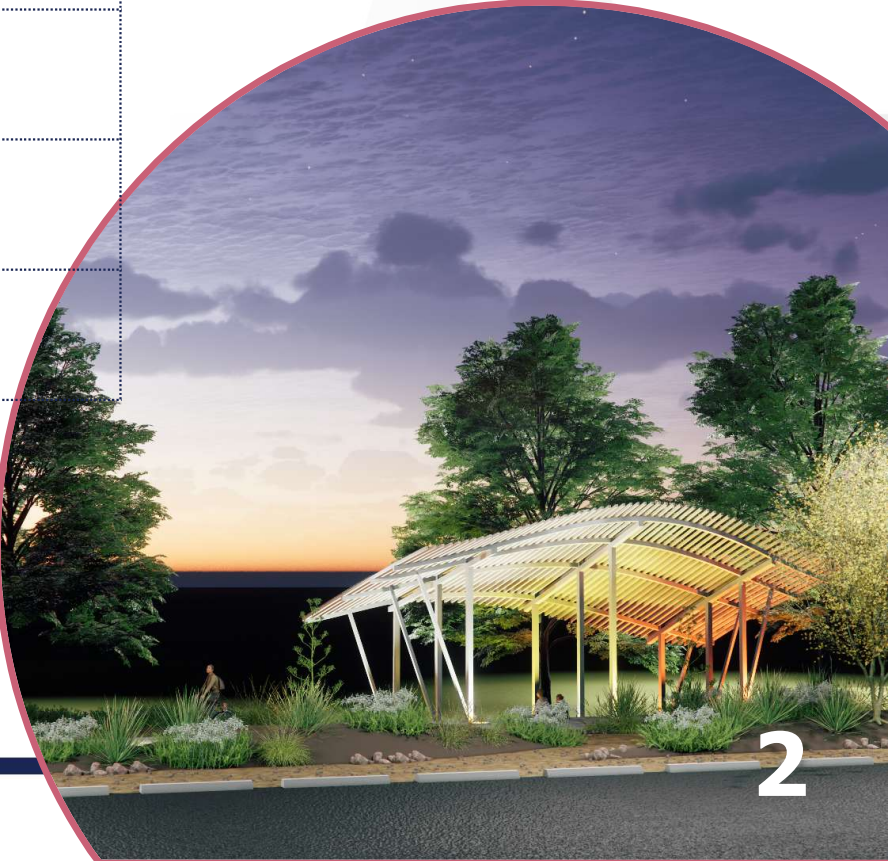

Overview Project

The Sun City Lights – District 6 project reflects a community-driven vision rooted in local identity. Centrally located within the district, Marty Robbins Park is one of the most highly used family destinations and a key community anchor.

Inspired by the legacy of Marty Robbins, the design introduces an outdoor amphitheater that celebrates music and storytelling. Combined with integrated seating, enhanced landscaping, improved connectivity, and cohesive lighting, these enhancements create a safe, vibrant, and welcoming space that activates the park day and night

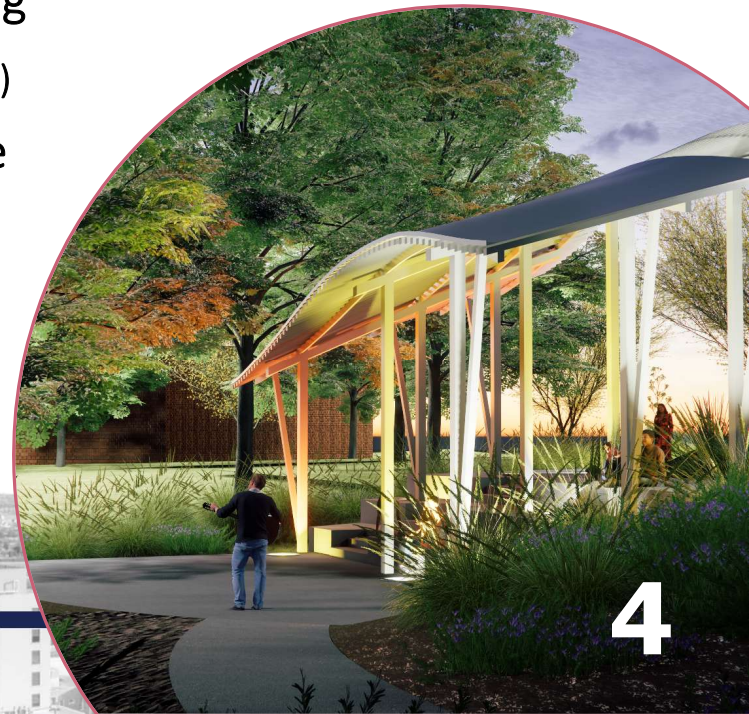
Based on approval of contract

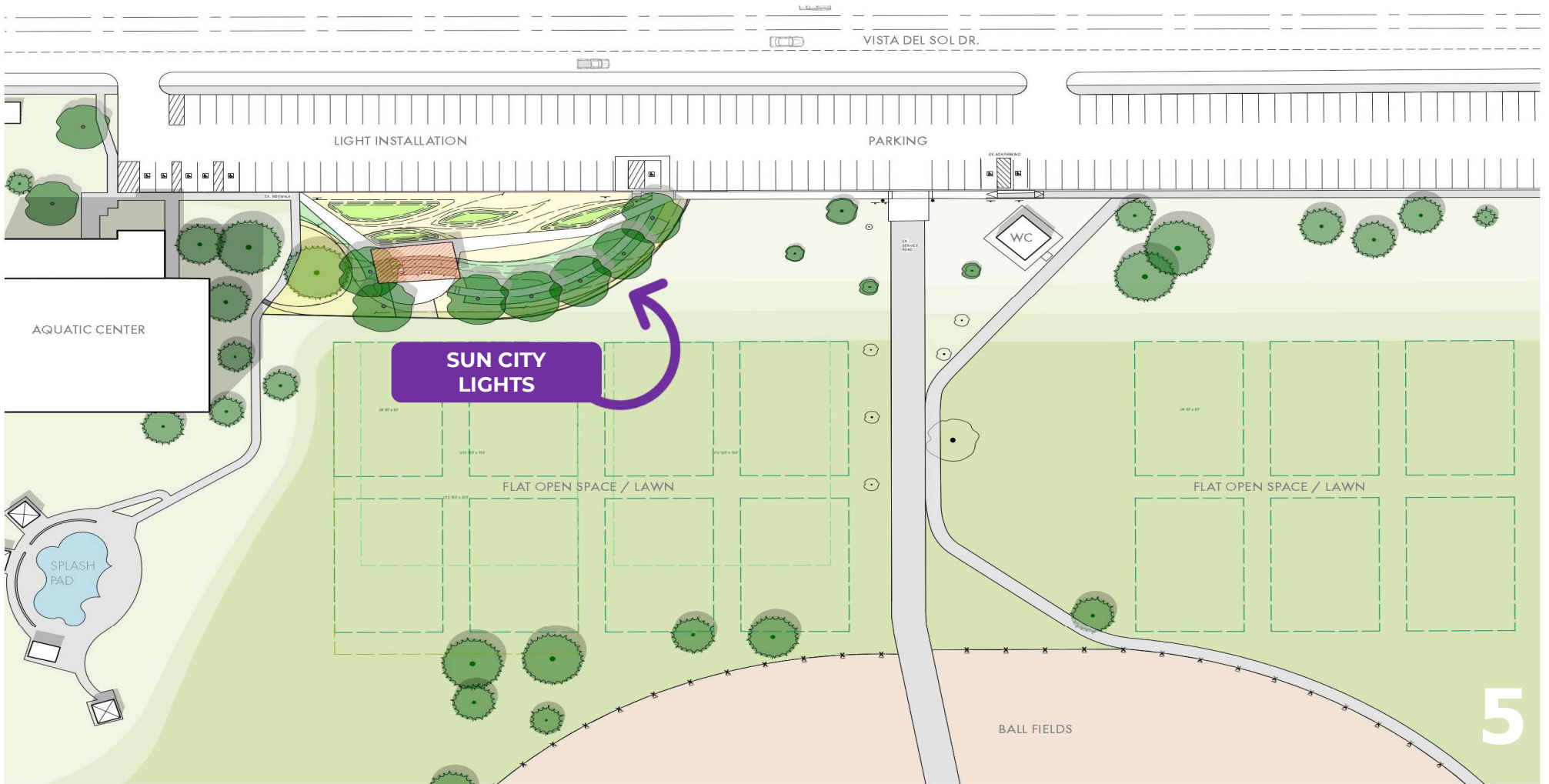
Scope of Work

The scope of work will include:

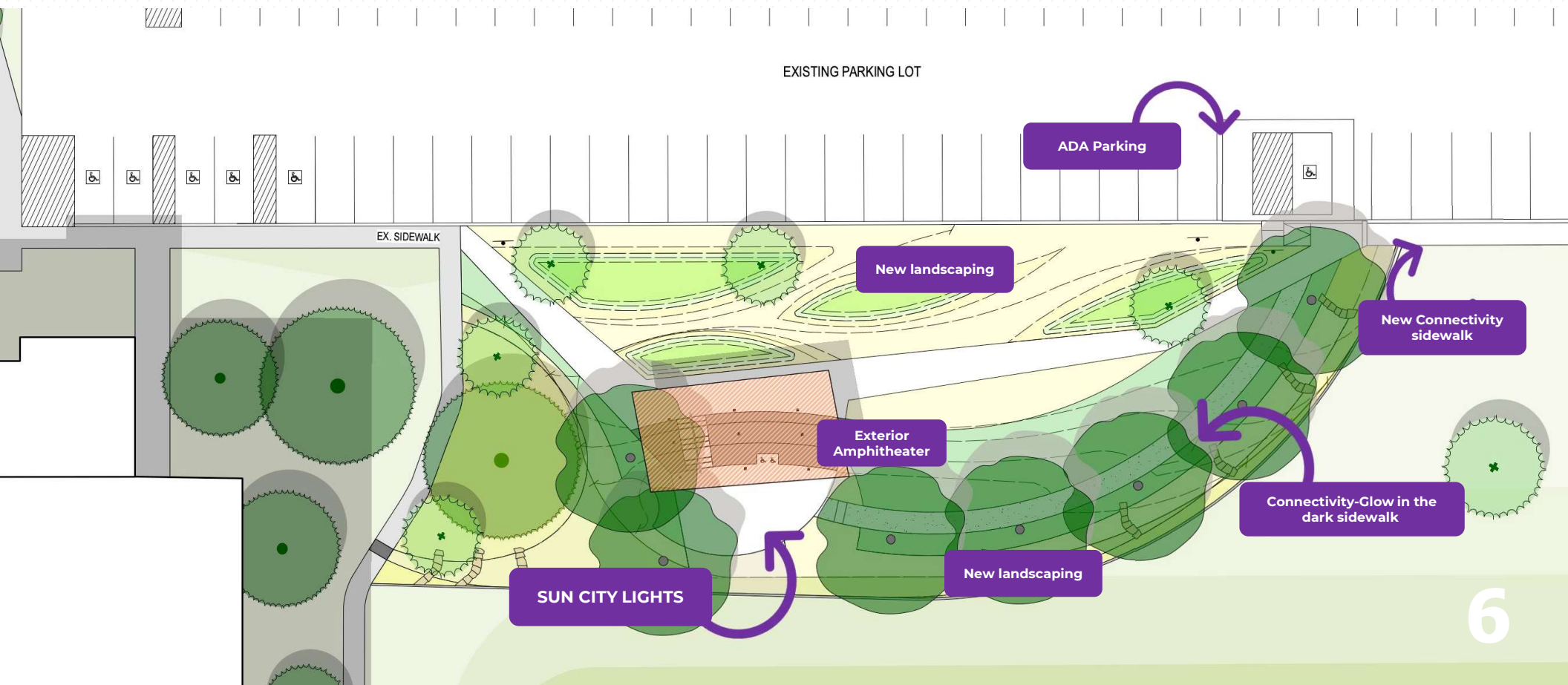
- Outdoor amphitheater with integrated seating & lighting
