BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

This agenda item is for City Council to appoint a member to the El Paso Water Utilities Public Service Board of Trustees. A vacancy in the El Paso Water Utilities Public Service Board occurred on December 12, 2024 with the resignation of the first term of Lisa Saenz, who filled the position, which required expertise in the area of Financial Management.

On February 18, 2025, as required by Ordinance Number 017167, the El Paso Water Utilities Public Service Board Selection Committee (hereinafter "Selection Committee") met and reviewed the applications submitted by the qualified applicants. Mayor Johnson served as Chairperson of the Selection Committee. The Selection Committee's membership consists of the Public Service Board members, which includes the Mayor, and eight persons appointed by City Council, one for each district. The Selection Committee now forwards a slate of three qualified candidates in order of their ranking to the City Council for consideration and appointment.

Advertisements for applicants interested in this position were placed in the El Paso, Inc., and on the City of El Paso and El Paso Water websites.

PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION:

Has the Council previously considered this item or a closely related one?

Yes. The City Council approved a Resolution on June 11, 2024, appointing Dr. Hector Ocaranza to fill a vacancy of the El Paso Water Utilities Public Service Board of Trustees in the area of expertise of Environment and Health Management.
