Project Scope

- The Border Highway West Shared Use Path Project consists of construction of a shared use path from Racetrack to Executive Center Blvd (0.589 miles). The Shared Use Path will run parallel to Border Highway east and serve as a continuation of the existing path.
- The proposed improvements includes:
 - Demolition
 - ADA compliant curb ramps
 - Concrete flume
 - Concrete header curbs and small stem wall
 - Irrigated landscaping with amenities
 - Pavement markings and signs.

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

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


RACETRACK PROPOSED TYPICAL SECTION
