

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Chevron Oronite Company LLC ("**Oronite**"), a company that develops, manufactures and markets chemicals and additives for lubricating oils and fuels, previously entered into an agreement with the City of El Paso ("**City**") through its Mass Transit Department ("**Sun Metro**") to run a field test where Sun Metro tests Oronite's oil on Sun Metro's buses ("field test"); and

WHEREAS, as part of the field test, Sun Metro receives free oil for the buses it will run the field test on and Sun Metro must in return provide oil performance information to Oronite; and

WHEREAS, the agreement for such field test has expired and Oronite has requested that Sun Metro continue the field test program by entering into a new agreement; and

WHEREAS, Sun Metro wishes to continue the field test program as participating on it has been beneficial for the City in the past; and

WHEREAS, as part of the agreement, Oronite will supply oil and sampling equipment for the Sun Metro vehicles participating in the field test at no cost to Sun Metro, and Sun Metro will run the field test on buses powered by Cummins L9N engines; and

WHEREAS, the Field Test reduces operating costs for Sun Metro's natural gas bus fleet and therefore enhances public transportation provided for the City of El Paso, which in turn enhances the quality of life for the citizens of the City of El Paso.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MASS TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

1. **THAT**, the City Manager be authorized to sign a Field Test Agreement ("Agreement") in a form substantially similar to Exhibit A, by and between the **CITY OF EL PASO** and **CHEVRON ORONITE COMPANY, LLC.**, to test oils on buses operated by the City of El Paso's Mass Transit Department, for a term beginning on the date the Agreement is executed and ending on September 1, 2029.
2. **THAT**, the City Manager or designee be authorized to take actions necessary and effectuate any budget transfers, sign any related agreements and amendments to such agreements after review and approval by the City Attorney's office, as well as sign any documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

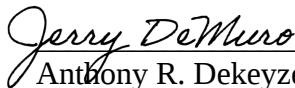
