Shade Canopy Program

Park Selection Criteria

- Equitable distribution of shade structures across districts
- Community feedback identifying playground shades as a constituent priority
- GIS analysis identifying gaps in existing shade canopy coverage
- Elevated consideration for parks with documented community requests
- Park usage and visitation levels
- Existing availability of shade amenities
- Playground equipment age and projected lifecycle needs

Shade Canopy Program Phase 1

- **Funding Source:** Community Progress Bond 2022
 - *Bond approved by Council on Nov. 8, 2022*
- **Total Program Budget: \$5M**
- **Phase 1 Budget: \$3M**
