

Up to seventy-five (75) percent of the funds from the paid curbside parking spaces within the District shall be set aside to pay for improvements and administrative costs within the District, with the remaining twenty-five (25) percent reserved for parking meter maintenance, connectivity fees, and equipment upgrades.





City Council Action Request

That the City Council approve amendments to the municipal code Title 12, Chapter 12.58.030 (Parking Benefit District Requirements) for the reinstatement of the Uptown Parking Benefit District Advisory Committee, reducing the membership requirement to five (5) members, hold quarterly meetings, and allow up to seventy-five (75) percent of the funds collected from paid curbside parking spaces be set aside for a collective to be allocated for improvements within the district, with the remainder twenty-five (25) percent reserved for International Bridges administrative costs of maintaining the meter system, to include repairs and maintenance, equipment upgrades and replacements, and connectivity fees.
