Workforce Solutions Borderplex: Bridging Opportunity for Business Growth with a Ready Workforce

Approximately 48 employees will receive training and/or certification in infrastructure skillsets

- Training grants up to \$10,000 from WSB
- Participating businesses will provide a match between 10% and 50% of program cost
- Solar Techs, Welders, Water Techs, Fiber Broadband Techs, Power Line Techs, Heavy Equipment Operators, Instrumentation Techs
- Expected Outcome Increased productivity, wages and economic mobility

- 300 small businesses will receive mentoring, coaching and consulting services

 - 15 Phase 2 workshops will apply the knowledge of creating an improved diverse and culturally enriched business environment
 - Expected outcome Increase resilience and talent retention in small businesses
