Resolutions for City Consent for “Road Powers” to MUDs 3 and 4


Background

- Municipal Utility Districts (MUD) created to facilitate development where municipalities or services cannot be extended
 - Finance tool
- El Paso County MUDs 3 and 4 were created in 2008
 - Located in City of El Paso's eastside extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ)
 - Currently has authority to finance the construction and maintenance of water, wastewater, and drainage infrastructure within their boundaries

- Texas Water Code Chapters 49 and 54 allows for the petition to TCEQ the ability to construct and maintain roadways
 - Requires City consent
- Request is for City of El Paso consent for road powers for MUDs 3 and 4
