

# State Legislative Priorities

#### **Hot Topics**

- Texas-Mexico Border Security
  - Impact of state/local participation in border security, transnational criminal activity affecting commerce, & interagency border operations
- Energy Grid Resilience
  - Incentivization of thermal generation & variable resources to increase grid capacity





# State Legislative Priorities

#### **Preemption Threats**

- Property Taxes
  - Potential homestead exemption increase and/or elimination of all property taxes
- Scrutiny of ARPA Spending by Local Governments





### State Legislative Priorities Cont.


#### **Resource Opportunities**

- Mental Health
  - Funding for mental health service expansion, particularly for children/veterans & inpatient facilities
- Transportation
  - Support for aviation and international ports of entry to meet current and future growth demands




# Increased Funding for Infrastructure

Legislative priorities include:

- International bridge expansion & funding
- Enhanced flood prevention & stormwater management
- Expansion of broadband access
- Support for military value projects that strengthen Texas military installations





# Increased Public Health & Safety Resources

Legislative priorities include:

- Increased/sustainable funding for equipment
- Support for gear/equipment changes due to PFAS-chemicals ban
- Increased support for emergency management






# Expanded Workforce Development Programs

Legislative priorities include:

- Expanded workforce development programs to allow municipalities to access funding
- Creation & retention of incentive programs to grow our region's workforce within highly competitive & emerging trades/sectors including:
  - Advanced Manufacturing
  - Aerospace
  - Defense
  - Information Technology





#### Riders


Riders are amendments to legislation that secure funding for specific programs or projects.

- Funding is approved in the State Budget
- Appropriations are directed at specific programs and projects under state agencies like TxDOT and Texas Parks and Wildlife Department
- State Delegation must sponsor Rider requests

Last Rider Awarded: \$32M for ITS Technology
