Hector I. Ocaranza, M.D.



- New Cases and Hospital admissions remain low
- Expecting to see a steady rise by end of fall
- New Hospital admission and severity of cases will increase mostly on those that have not receive a recent booster
- Bivalent Booster now approved for 5 yrs of age and older
- Omicron Sub-variants BA.4 and BA.5 continue to be the most prevalent
- Recommending our community to stay up to date with vaccine by receiving new Bivalent booster dose

- Influenza season starting now
- Increased flu activity in the state is seen now
- Experts have warned about severe flu season 2022-2023
- Recommend vaccination against flu to prevent hospitalization
- Non-pharmacological prevention very useful against flu and other respiratory viruses
- City community clinics administering flu vaccine free of charge and no appointment necessary

- All patients recovered without complications
- Cases declining across the US and the state
- Vaccination is being done in phases:
  - Initial phase to close contacts of confirmed cases
  - Next phase of vaccination was to those high risk under the care of a healthcare provider
  - Existing phase open to anyone who consider themselves as high risk and by appointment only
