Discussion and action on a resolution to approve an amendment to the City's 2021-2022 (47th Year) Annual

Action Plan and 2022-2023 (48th Year) Annual Action Plan for the Community Development Block Grant Entitlement (CDBG-EN) to:

- a. Increase the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project/activity budget for Wheelchair Ramps at Lakehurst Rd. and Saratoga Dr. to \$95,237.24 utilizing unprogrammed CDBG funds from prior years; and
- b. Increase the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project/activity budget for Wheelchair Ramps along Wadsworth Ave. to \$388,649.27 utilizing unprogrammed CDBG funds from prior years; and
- c. Increase the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project/activity budget for Sidewalks along Byron St. to \$341,295.35 utilizing unprogrammed CDBG funds from prior years.

#### **BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:**

Due to unforeseen site conditions and increased material and labor costs, the three CDBG-funded projects require additional funding to complete the intended scope of work. The projects and scopes of work are:

**Sidewalks along Byron Street** – Along Byron St. between Mobile Ave. and Memphis Ave., 79930 – Installation of sidewalks and 8 ADA directional ramps along Byron St.

Wheelchair Ramps at Lakehurst Rd and Saratoga Dr. – Intersections along Lakehurst Rd and Saratoga Dr around Centennial Dr and Thorn Ave, 79912 – Installation of ADA directional ramps at 12 corners along Lakehurst Rd and Saratoga Dr.

**Wheelchair Ramps along Wadsworth Ave.** – Along Wadsworth Ave between Olga St. and Sidney St., 79924. Installation of 18 ADA directional ramps at 9 corners along Wadsworth Ave.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council, based on the recommendation of the Department of Community and Human Development, now desires to amend the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan and 2022-2023 Annual Action plan to increase funding for three projects contained within those plans; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 20, 2023 the City of El Paso posted on its website public notice and allowed a 30-day public comment period regarding the proposed amendments to the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan and 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan and City Council has duly considered public comment if any.

# NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

- 1. That the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan is hereby amended as follows:
  - a. Increase the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project/activity budget for Wheelchair Ramps at Lakehurst Rd. and Saratoga Dr. to \$95,237.24 utilizing unprogrammed CDBG funds from prior years.
- 2. That the 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan is hereby amended as follows:
  - a. Increase the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project/activity budget for Wheelchair Ramps along Wadsworth Ave. to \$388,649.27 utilizing unprogrammed CDBG funds from prior years; and
  - b. Increase the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project/activity budget for Sidewalks along Byron St. to \$341,295.35 utilizing unprogrammed CDBG funds from prior years.
- 3. That the Department of Community and Human Development, through the Climate and Sustainability Officer, be authorized to make the above changes to the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan and 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan in the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development's program system.

4. That the City Manager, or designee, be authorized to take any actions necessary to accomplish the intent of this resolution upon approval by the City Attorney's Office and Climate and Sustainability Officer.
5. Except as herein amended, the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan and 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan remain in full force and effect.
