Rosa Avenue was named and established as a 50-foot right-of-way on April 10, 1916. On September 11, 2025, the City Plan Commission recommended unanimous approval of the street name change request.

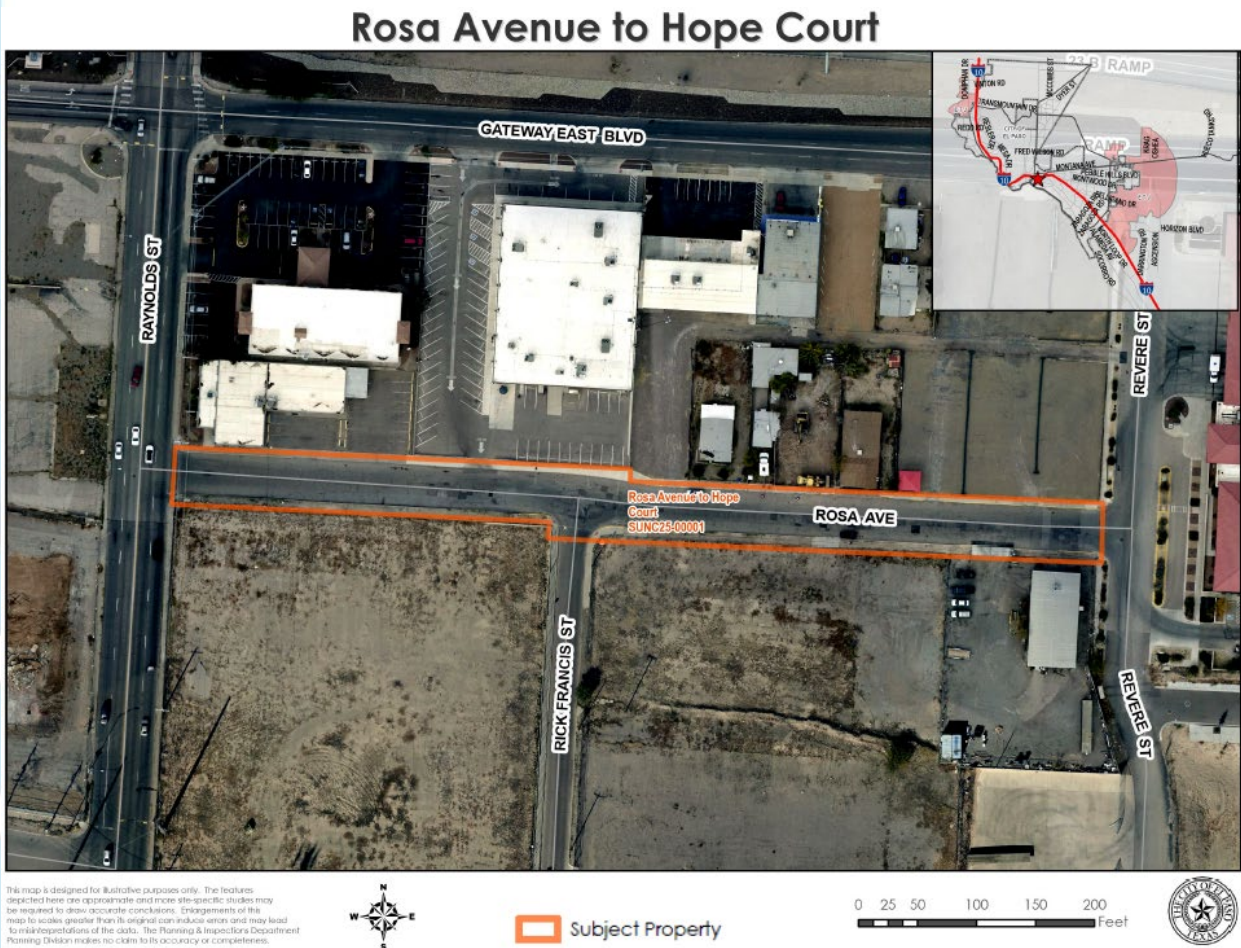


Figure A: Street with surrounding area

DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST: The applicant is proposing to rename a portion of Rosa Avenue (from Raynolds Street to Revere Street) to Hope Court. The applicant considers Hope Court a suitable name in order to mark the key entry point to a future Cancer Center. All property owners abutting the subject right-of-way are in agreement with the proposed street name change request.

CASE HISTORY/RELATED APPLICATIONS: Rosa Avenue was named and established as a 50-foot right-of-way on April 10, 1916.

STREET CHARACTER: Rosa Avenue runs West/East from Raynolds Street to Revere Street. Rosa Avenue is classified as a local street per the City of El Paso's Major Thoroughfare Plan (MTP).

PUBLIC COMMENT: N/A

CITY PLAN COMMISSION OPTIONS:

The City Plan Commission (CPC) has the authority to advise City Council on street name change requests. When a request is brought forward to the CPC for review, the Commission may take any of the following actions:

El Paso Water

EPWater does not object to this request. EPWater requests a copy of the official street name change to update our records.

Water:

There is an existing 8-inch diameter water main extending along Rosa Ave., between Raynolds St and Rick Francis St. The water main is located approximately 15 feet south of the northern property line. This main is available to provide service.

There is an existing 4-inch diameter water main extending along Rosa Ave., between Rick Francis St. and Revere St. The water main is located approximately 17 feet south of the northern property line. This main is available to provide service.

Sanitary Sewer:

There is an existing 8-inch diameter sanitary sewer main extending along Rosa Ave. The sewer main is located approximately 20 feet north of the southern property line. This main is available to provide service.

General:

EPWater requires a new service application to provide service to the property. New service applications are available at 1154 Hawkins, 3rd floor and should be made 6 to 8 weeks in advance of construction to ensure water for construction work. A site plan, utility plan, grading and drainage plans, landscaping plan, the legal description of the property and a certificate-of-compliance are required at the time of application. Service will be provided in accordance with the current EPWater – PSB Rules and Regulations. The applicant is responsible for the costs of any necessary on-site and off-site extensions, relocations or adjustments of water and sanitary sewer lines and appurtenances.

Stormwater:

EPWater – SW has reviewed the above-described subdivision and has no objection to its approval.

Fire Department

No adverse comments.

Texas Department of Transportation

No TXDOT comments as there appears to be no work affecting the ROW.

Texas Gas

In reference to case SUNC25-00001 - Rosa Ave to Hope St, Texas Gas Service does not have any comments.
