Describe What Happened (Continued from first page)					
On June 30, 2025, a physical altercation occurred between two groups of basketball players during open gym					
nours. Immediately after the incident, all individuals involved left the center and were not identified at the time.					
On July 2, 2025, two individuals from one of the groups, identified as T'Affalous and T'Var, returned to participate in open gym. I approached them, presented the Code of Conduct, and informed them of a possible suspension					
pending review of the incident. Both individuals stated that they were victims in the situation and claimed they					
were only defending themselves. They refused to sign the Code of Conduct.					
I informed them that, based on the security footage, one of them appeared to initiate the fight by pushing a					
female member of the opposing group. While they disagreed with this assessment, they acknowledged the potential suspension and stated their intent to appeal the decision.					
Later that day, T'Affalous and T'Var returned to request to view the video footage, claiming they had a legal right					
to do so. I informed them that any video footage requests must be submitted through the open records process.					
At approximately 12:50 PM the same day, staff notified me that members of the second group had arrived to play					
basketball. I approached them immediately to issue the Code of Conduct and inform them of the possible					
suspension. The male identified himself as Paris, and the female as Danae Gonzalez.					
Paris expressed disagreement with the suspension recommendation, stating that he was defending Danae as I would defend my mother or sister. I explained that the decision was based on a review of the footage. Paris					
provided his name but declined to sign the Code of Conduct. Danae signed and acknowledged receipt of the Code.

City of El Paso Parks & Recreation Department Code of Conduct



Recreation programs in this community are made possible by a significant commitment of financial and human resources. The benefits a participant derives from this investment depends very much on the participant's attitude toward the program and the participant's adherence to high standards of behavior.

The Participants Code of Conduct that follows is the Department's specific response to requirements set by the Texas Department of Protective and Regulatory Services. The law requires Parks and Recreation Department officials to define misconduct that could lead to specific disciplinary consequences. This code provides information and directions to participants regarding standards of behavior as well as consequences of misconduct.

Each participant is expected to do the following:

- Demonstrate courtesy even when others do not.
- · Behave in a responsible manner, always exercising self discipline.
- · Respect the rights and privileges of other participants and City staff.
- · Respect the property of others, including City property and facilities.
- · Cooperates with or assists the City staff in maintaining safety, order and discipline.

Unacceptable behaviors include the following:

- Being involved in an instance of any form of insubordination.
- · Failure to conform to all city rules.
- · Use of profanity, vulgar language or obscene gestures.
- · Defacing/damaging city property or the property of others.
- Engaging in inappropriate physical or verbal contact and/or gang activity.
- Running, pushing, shoving, littering, throwing objects (which is not part of a supervised activity).
- Producing loud, rude or unnecessary noises.
- Incidents involving drugs, alcohol, weapons.

Persons behaving in unacceptable manners as listed above may face the following discipline options:

- Conference with staff and person involved in misbehavior.
- Conference with staff and Parent/Legal Guardian, when appropriate.
- If a parent/Legal guardian refuses to attend the conference concerning a minor or the person remains disruptive, the person may be restricted from the program.
- Suspension from participation in program(s)
- · Restitution, when appropriate.
- Notification of outside agencies and/or police when appropriate.
- Acts of misbehavior of a violent nature will result in automatic suspensions.
