Letter from center participants regarding Mr. Estrada's behavior

Urgent Follow-Up on Inappropriate Behavior by Mr. Antonio Estrada

Due to the increasing frequency of complaints regarding Mr. Antonio Estrada's behavior, we believe it is urgent to take action, as several individuals have expressed concern over his conduct. The recurring complaints indicate that Mr. Estrada speaks to others in a disrespectful manner, uses inappropriate language, raises his voice frequently, and often involves himself in matters that do not concern him. It is important to note that Mr. Estrada has already received a verbal warning, so the logical next step would be to proceed with a suspension. Unfortunately, we do not have written statements from the individuals affected, as many of them have expressed fear of Mr. Estrada's potentially violent reactions. As a result, they prefer to avoid the situation rather than submit a formal complaint. Below are two recent incidents that were personally reported in the office last week:

- 1. Incident involving Ms. María de la Cruz Molina Thursday July 3, 2025 Ms. Molina came to the office visibly upset after an altercation with Mr. Estrada during an activity. According to her statement, while she was preparing to hand over her money to participate in a game, she took a moment to get it from her purse. Mr. Estrada reacted by grabbing the money and throwing it at her, telling her she could no longer play. Ms. Molina, shocked and upset, confronted him and asked him to stop being so rude and disrespectful. Mr. Estrada then became even more aggressive.
- 2. Incident involving Ms. Juana Serrano and Ms. Rosalba Piña Wednesday July 2,2025

Ms. Serrano, who serves meals from the county as a volunteer, came to the office to report that Mr. Estrada entered the kitchen and made unpleasant comments, raising his voice and speaking very rudely to the nutrition staff member, Ms. Rosalba Piña. I personally spoke with Ms. Piña, who confirmed the incident and mentioned that this was not the first time Mr. Estrada had approached her to complain about the food in an inappropriate and disrespectful manner.

These behaviors are unacceptable and compromise the respectful and safe environment we strive to maintain at our center. We respectfully request that appropriate action be taken as soon as possible to prevent further incidents affecting our staff and other members of the center.

Estimado Sr. Jose Esquivel,

Esta carta sirve como queja formal contra otro miembro que atiende actividades en Pavo Real Senior Center. El incidente que ocurrio el 3 de Julio 2025 no es el primero. Varios miembros han tenido experiencias similares con la misma persona.

E 3 de Julio 2025, los miembros estábamos jugando Bingo. Cada miembro voluntariamente contribuía \$1.00 por juego. Entre las horas de 12:30 y 1:00 p.m., yo avise' que no hiba a participar en el siguiente juego. Yo cambie de parecer. Decidí participar en el juego. Yo puse mi dolar en la mesa. No hubo queja o problema ninguno con los otros miembros. Mi queja es contra el Señor Antonio "Tony". El Señor Tony, muy agitado levanto mi dolar de la mesa y con des respeto lanzó él dólar hacia mi. Teno muchos testigos de que el señor empezó a I levantar su voz. Tuvimos un argumento. El señor Tony se mostró beligerante. No estoy dispuesta a tolerar ese tipo de conducta. Las personas que vamos al centro de Pavo Real vamos a pasar un tiempo ameno y a divertirnos sanamente con otras personas de nuestra edad. El señor Tony es particularmente grosero e irrespetuoso con los miembros femeninos.

Quiero respetuosamente pedir que se conduzca una investigación sobre este y otros incidentes que han ocurrido durante 2024 y 2025. No es justo que miembros dejen de sentirse seguros o con miedo de ser verbalmente agredidos. Escribo esta carta para darle la oportunidad de que exitosamente se resuelva este problema. El señor Tony necesita comprender que su conducta abrupta e irrespetuosa debe y necesita tener consecuencias. Al haber no consecuencias, esto potencialmente incita a otros miembros que tengan comportamientos y actitudes similares. Al no haber investigación o resuelva, me vere obligada a contactar verbalmente o vía carta o correo electrónico a la cadena de mando de Pavo Real Senior Center. Dear Mr. Jose Esquivel,

This letter serves as a formal complaint against another member who attends activities at the Pavo Real Senior Center. The incident that occurred on July 3, 2025, is not the first. Several members have had similar experiences with the same person.

On July 3, 2025, the members were playing Bingo. Each member voluntarily contributed \$1.00 per game. Between 12:30 and 1:00 p.m., I announced that I would not be participating in the next game. I changed my mind. I decided to participate in the game. I put my dollar on the table. There were no complaints or problems with the other members. My complaint is against Mr. Antonio "Tony." Mr. Tony, very agitated, picked up my dollar from the table and disrespectfully threw it at me. I have many witnesses who saw that the man began to raise his voice. We had an argument. Mr. Tony was belligerent. I am not willing to tolerate that kind of behavior. The people who go to the Pavo Real center want to have a good time and enjoy ourselves in a healthy way with other people our age. Mr. Tony is particularly rude and disrespectful to the female members.

I respectfully request that an investigation be conducted into this and other incidents that have occurred during 2024 and 2025. It is not fair that members should feel unsafe or afraid of being verbally abused. I am writing this letter to give you the opportunity to successfully resolve this issue. Mr. Tony needs to understand that his abrupt and disrespectful behavior must and should have consequences. The lack of consequences potentially encourages other members to engage in similar behavior and attitudes. If there is no investigation or resolution, I will be forced to contact the chain of command at Pavo Real Senior Center verbally or via letter or email.
