Chapter 380 Strategic Program Agreement for Expansion of Existing Operation in Northwest El Paso

Background: Policy Alignment

- Project aligns with the City's 380 Incentive Policy, including capital investment, quality job creation/retention, target industry (advanced manufacturing + energy and sustainability), supply chain (eMobility, Aerospace, Information & Technology Services).
- After incentive value and the cost of government services, the project's expansion provides a net benefit to the City.
- **Recommendation:** Move forward with the Chapter 380 Agreement



Background: Company Overview

- Manufacturer of electronic switch gear to support electrical infrastructure to support demand for data center solutions
- \$47B in global revenue in FY2023
- \$140M to be invested in the US in 2024, announced \$85M in Tennessee
- Company currently has multiple locations in El Paso, and is looking to expand again



Background: Previous Action

Over the past 10 years, company will have invested **\$77.6M+** and directly created **1,998 jobs**

- \$7M investment in machinery and equipment
- 193 new fulltime jobs
- 250 retained

Proposed Expansion: Project Description

\$50,333,000 Minimum Capital Investment:

- New Building Construction: \$25,733,000
- Personal Property: \$24,600,000


Full-time Jobs Retained & Created:

- Retain 1,498 full-time jobs
- Create 500 full-time positions over 3 years (\$20 million annual payroll)
- \$39,000 average salary vs. \$36,005 for the El Paso County annual median wage rate (bls.gov)




Proposed Expansion: Local Incentive
