WHEREAS, the Borderland Rainbow Center is operated by a dedicated staff to include Lorena Edwards, Fernando Mendez, Andi Rose Ticareno, Veronica Camacho, Diana Martinez, Julie Lucas, Ashley Heidelbrecht, Alex Jacquez, Luis Orozco, and others who are committed to the cause; and
