

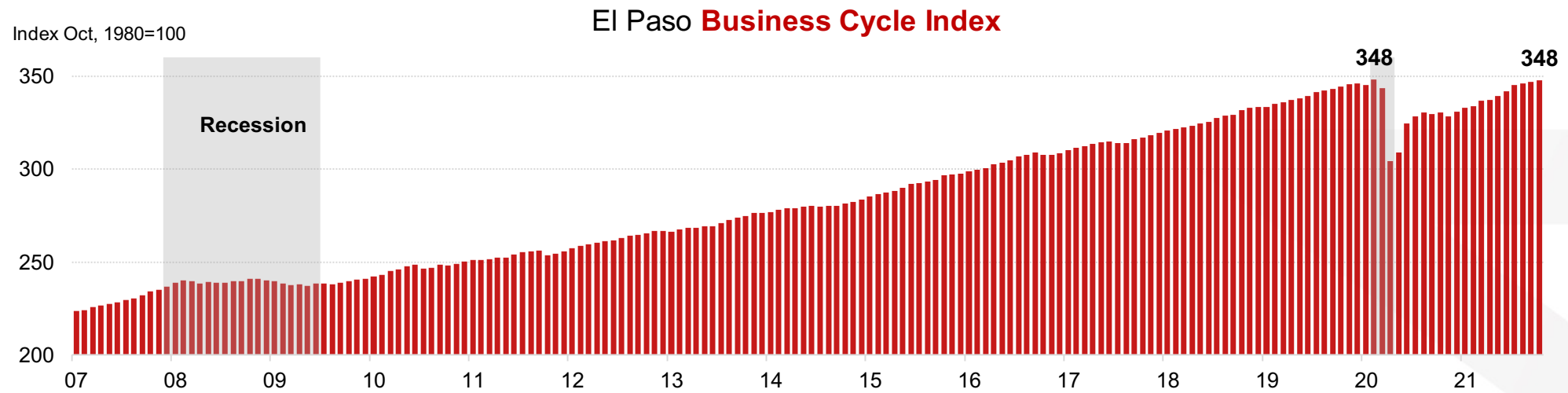

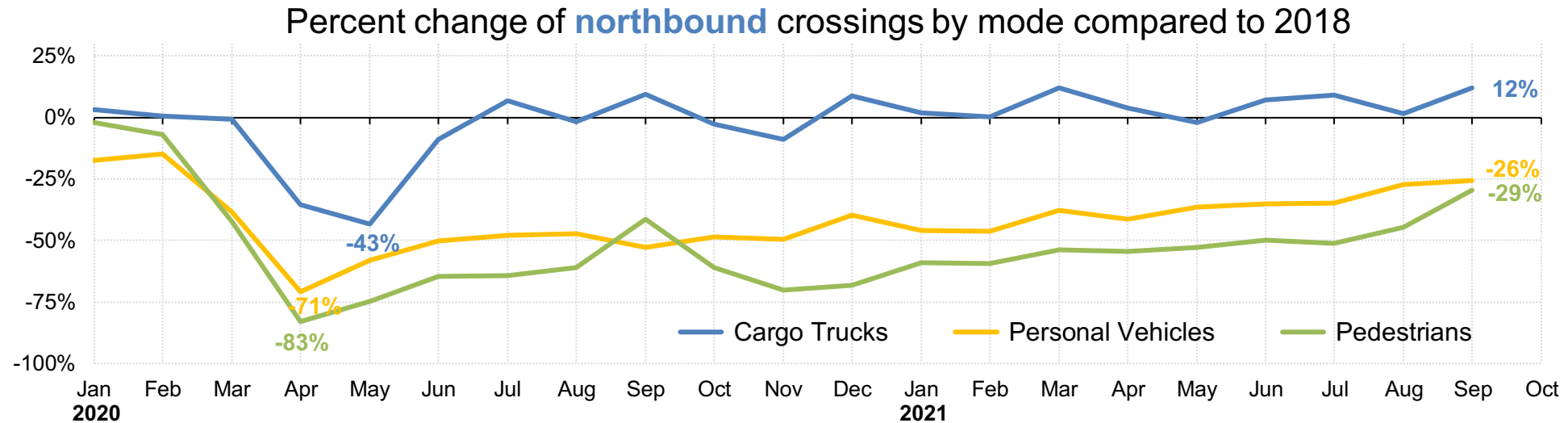
Business Cycle Index

The path to economic recovery seems to be **gaining steam** driven by **lower unemployment**

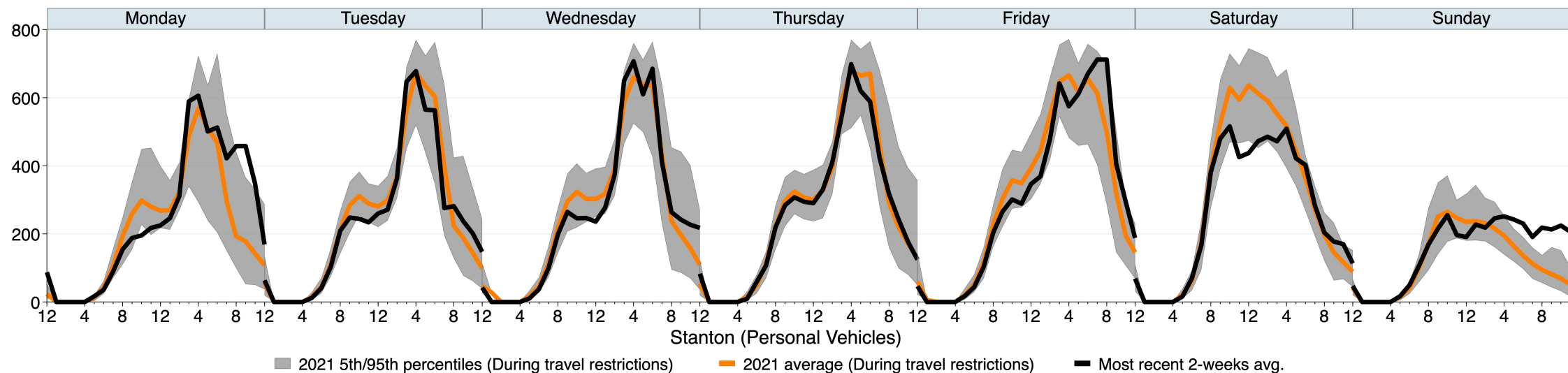

International Bridge Crossings

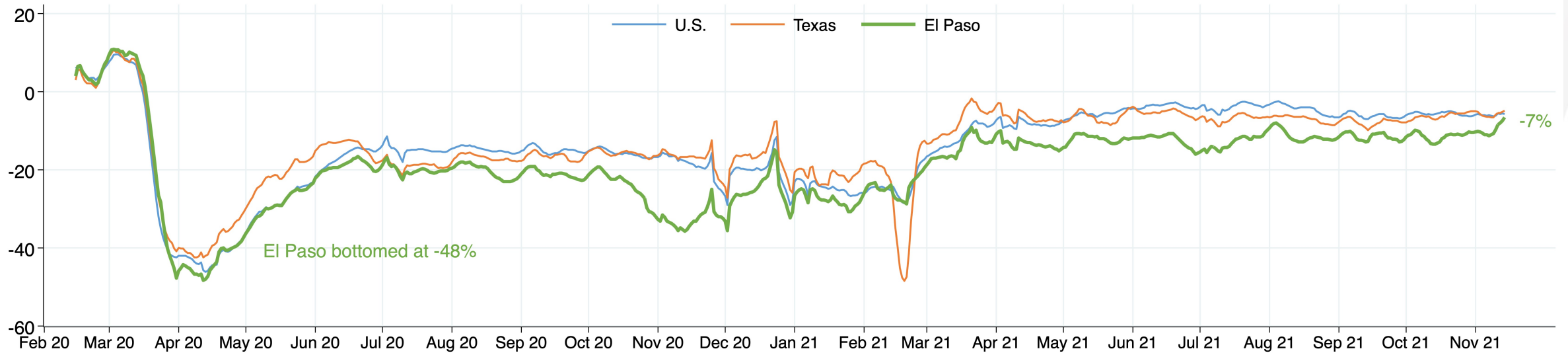

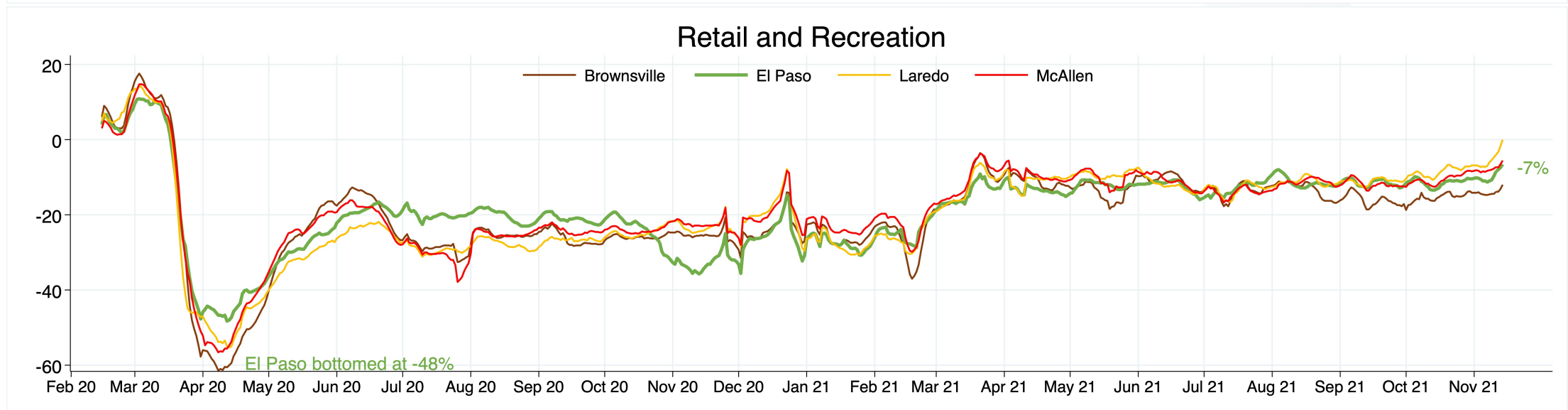
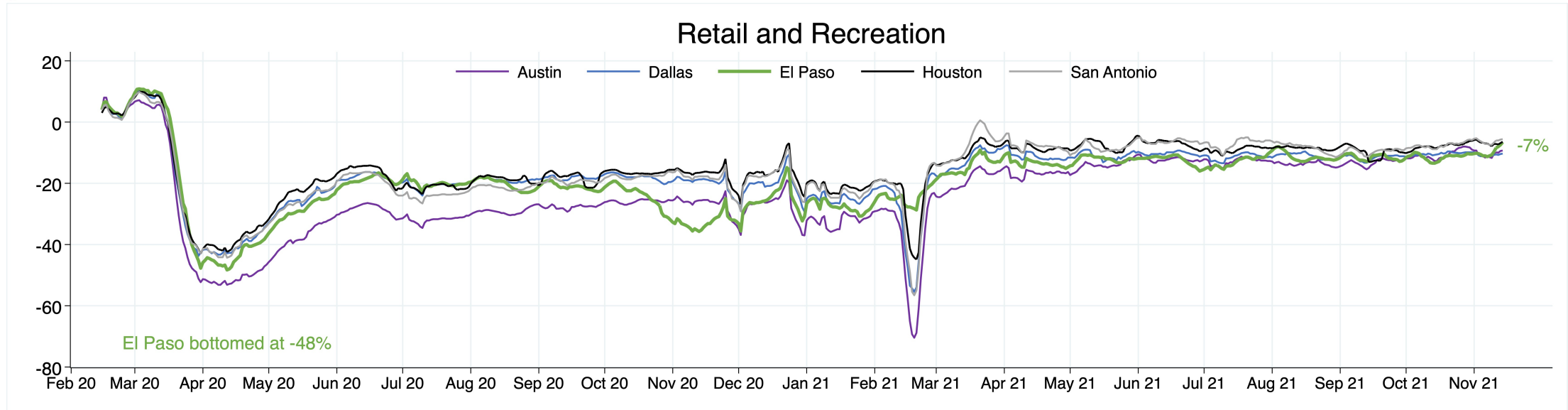

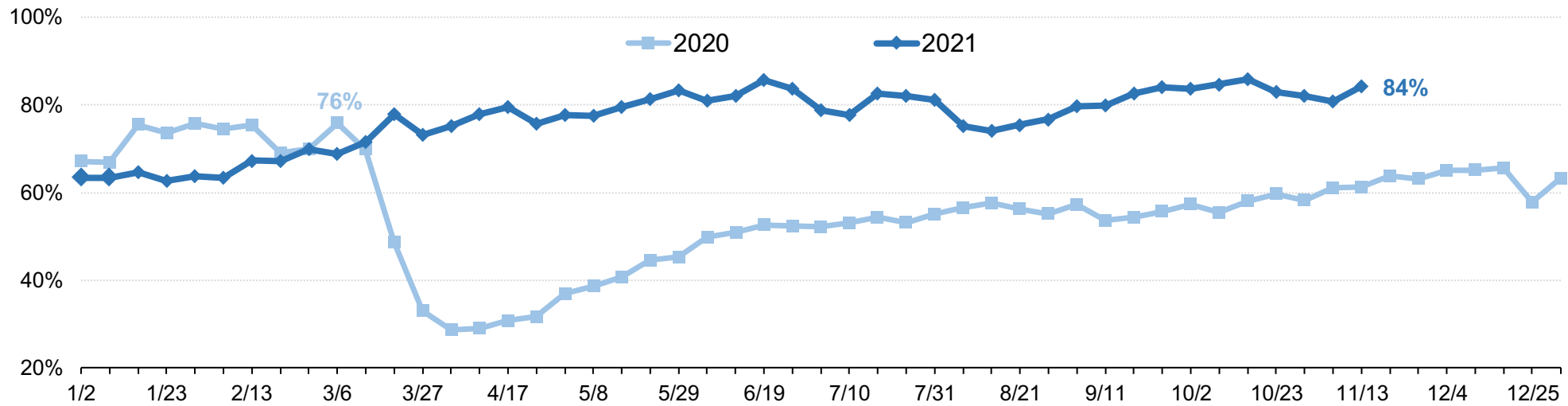

Hotel Occupancy (weekly average) **above** pre-pandemic levels (**84%**)

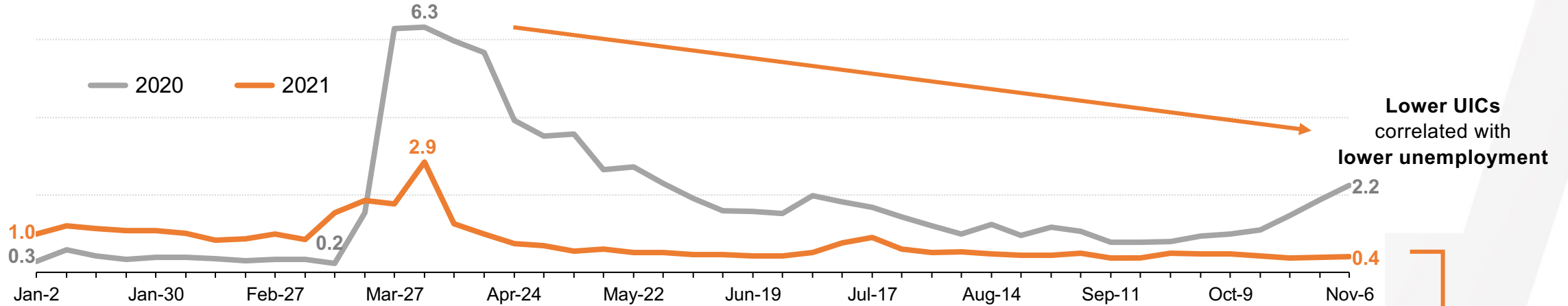

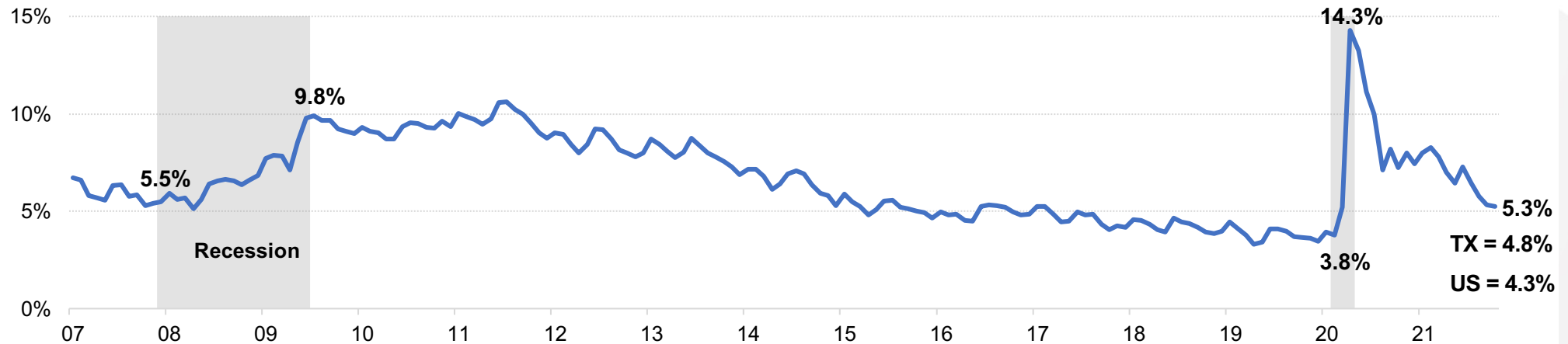
El Paso County Unemployment

El Paso County Weekly **Unemployment Insurance Claims** (in thousands)



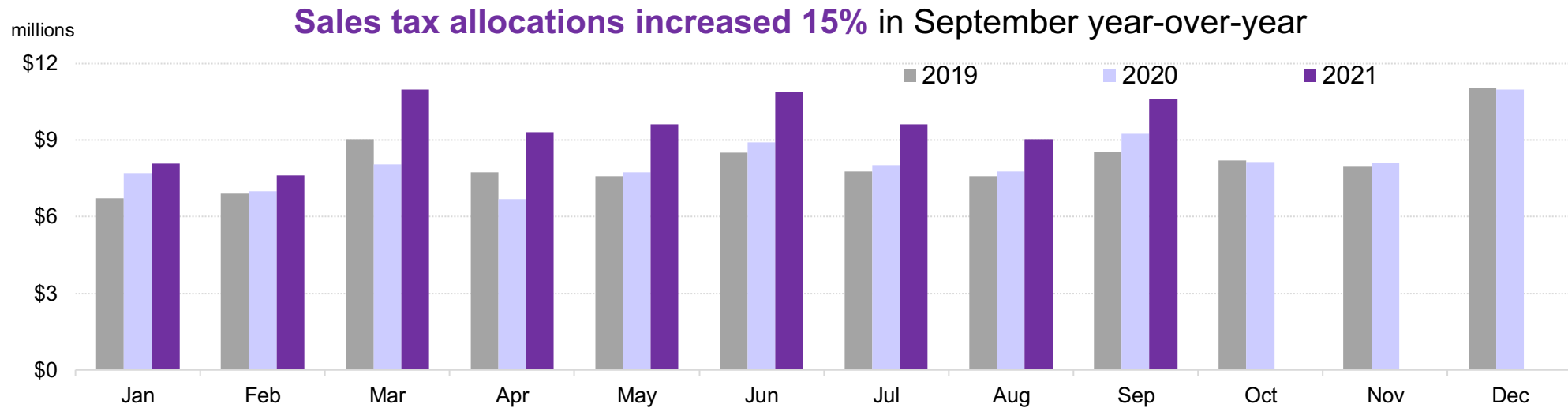
