About EDA Venture Challenge Grant



Goal: Support entrepreneurship and accelerate company growth in communities through tech-enabled economic development initiatives

- \$3M Project Total
 - \$1.5M awarded to El Paso Makes October 2021 by EDA
 - \$1.5M in matching funds from the City of El Paso



About Main Project Partners

EDA Venture Challenge Grant The Project:

Goal: Establish an Aerospace and Defense Supply Chain Innovation Network to support growth of our small and medium enterprises

- Enhance innovation and capabilities of our existing manufacturing sector
- UTEP's Aerospace Center will administer the grant on behalf of El Paso Makes Consortium









Project Benefits:

- Contribute towards incubation of extremely promising local industry
 - 60 local businesses will become competitive for DoD and NASA contracts
 - Combined annual growth will increase by 10% and add 200 new jobs to the El Paso economy
- Access to supplier database with information on seventy (70) partner businesses – allows us to target recruitment in supply chain
- Booth at each of three (3) annual supplier summits
- Invitation to travel with Innovation Network on twelve (12) marketing trips to the aerospace and defense industry
- Advance efforts related to the Advanced Manufacturing Center located at the El Paso International Airport
