## Purpose of Change Order



- This contract is a tool for the resurfacing of streets within the City of El Paso. This includes milling, paving, repair of concrete elements, and installation of ADA pedestrian paths throughout the City at selected resurfacing sites.
- This contract provides labor, materials, equipment and traffic control necessary to repair and/or maintain paved structures such as project streets, alleys, parking lots or other paved surfaces necessary to enhance and improve El Paso's street infrastructure Citywide.
- The change order will allow for this work to continue at favorable prices to amount of \$3.3 million.
