

- On April 18, 2022, a federal district court in FL ordered TSA to stop enforcing the mask mandate
- CDC continues to recommend the use of masks in indoor public transportation settings
- The DOJ has filed an appeal with the 11th Cir. COA










- Community Level as per CDC is still green

- Continue protecting the most vulnerable










# Pharmacological Interventions

- Attention is given to Long-COVID











The path to economic recovery seems to be gaining steam driven by lower unemployment



El Paso County Weekly Unemployment Insurance Claims (in thousands)



#### Sales tax allocations increased 18% in February year-over-year





#### **Cargo Crossings**






### **DPS Enhanced Inspections Impact**


Southbound Commercial Trucks (Ysleta-Zaragoza)
