Our Vision

The Vision of El Paso Children's Hospital is to enhance the lives of children from the greater El Paso area and surrounding region by providing a place of hope and healing through unmatched excellence in pediatric patient care, research and education.

Milestone

- El Paso Children's Hospital founding principle was to reduce the amount of children leaving El Paso to seek medical services.
 - 206,057 Emergency Department visits
 - 29,913 surgery and clinical procedures
 - 35,294 children hospitalized
 - 403,747 outpatient visits in Diagnostic Imaging, Laboratory, Hematology/Oncology, and Rehab areas
- Partnered with UMC of El Paso (El Paso County Hospital District).
- Collaborated with Texas Tech University Physicians to expand specialty medical services through Graduate Medical Education Programs.

Outmigration

- At inception, over 600 children were leaving the market on an annual basis
- Outmigration has been reduced by over 80% since EPCH opened
- Service a 350 mile radius
- Key programs are maturing:
 - Emergency Services to include trauma patients – joint with UMC and TTHUSC-EP
 - Pediatric Craniofacial Surgery
 - Pediatric Hematology and Oncology
 - Pediatric Gastroenterology

Spina Bifida Procedure

The Spina Bifida Clinic is a multidisciplinary clinic that provides a comprehensive approach to pediatric patients with birth defects that involve the spine. The team consists of Neurosurgery, Urology, Orthopedics, Case Management, and Physical Therapy. This clinic allows patients and their families the opportunity to seek specialized medical care within the same appointment. This collaborative effort helps ensure that our patients are provided the most complete care possible.

Outpatient Rehabilitative Services & Empower Program

Developmental and Rehabilitative Services at El Paso Children's Hospital

Speech-Language Pathology, Occupational Therapy and Physical Therapy services are available to help children reach their maximum potential. When illness, injury or birth defects keep a child from developing properly, we are here to help. El Paso Children's Hospital has a pediatric team offering innovative habilitation or rehabilitation in: Physical/ Gross Motor, Speech and Language, Oral-motor/ Swallowing and Hand/ Fine Motor skills. This facility provides comprehensive evaluations, individual therapy and family support.



Feeding Therapy

Speech-language pathologists work with individuals with deficits in oral-motor and/ or swallowing skills. Therapists facilitate improvement of lip, jaw, tongue and neck muscles to enhance feeding and swallowing skills. Oral-motor therapy follows development hierarchy to maximize progression of musculature to achieve optimum oral intake.

Speech Language Pathology

Speech-language pathologists work with individuals presenting with deficits in receptive and expressive language, articulation, fluency and voice skills. Therapy goals are to maximize communication through oral, written or signed language. Assistive or augmentative communication may also be incorporated.

The Empower Program at El Paso Children's Hospital is for children and teens who are at risk of developing or have been diagnosed with pre-diabetes or type 2 diabetes. Children and teens participating in the Empower Program work with a specialized team of Registered Dietitians and a Social Worker to receive a personalized plan to include specific, achievable goals to facilitate behavior changes, overcome barriers and help the whole family to be involved in becoming healthier. 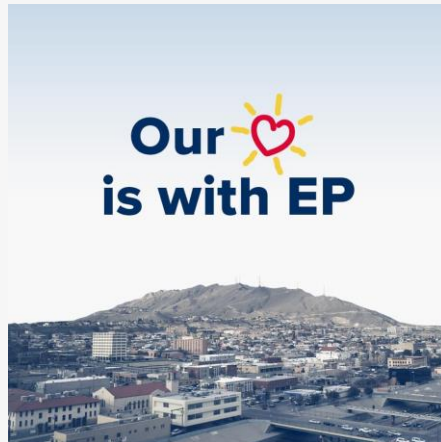

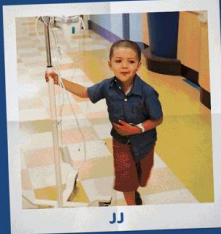
