CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION MINUTES December 13, 2021 COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL AND VIRTUALLY 9:05 AM

The City Council of the City of El Paso met at the above place and date. Meeting was called to order at 9:35 a.m. Mayor Oscar Leeser was present and presiding and the following Council Members answered roll call: Peter Svarzbein, Casandra Hernandez, Joe Molinar, Isabel Salcido, Claudia Rodriguez, Henry Rivera, and Cissy Lizarraga. Alexsandra Annello requested to be excused.

1. Presentation and discussion by the COVID-19 Response and Recovery Cross-Functional Team providing information on key activities, efforts and processes.

1. Overview (Tommy Gonzalez)

Mr. Tommy Gonzalez, City Manager, began the presentation by saying that the number of positive cases continued to rise with a positivity rate of 21% which was causing an impact to hospital capacity. Mr. Gonzalez added that a third of new cases were breakthrough cases and stated that among youths, a total of 59% were partially vaccinated while 33% were fully vaccinated. Mr. Gonzalez continued the overview by saying that the City was leading the State in the number of vaccinations and the positivity rate. He highlighted that vaccination boosters were available at City sites for those age 18 and older.

Ms. Karla Nieman, City Attorney, continued the presentation by explaining that the case filed by parents of disabled children related to the mask mandate was on hold and said the Federal Transportation Mask Mandate had been extended through March 18, 2022. She closed her briefing by stating that the Federal Contractor Vaccine Mandate required vaccination of federal contractors by January 4, 2022.

 - Dr. Hector Ocaranza, Public Health Authority, continued the presentation by highlighting

the sharp upward trend in community transmission and explaining the importance of vaccinations, boosters, and therapeutic measures such as infusions.

Mr. David Coronado, Managing Director for International Bridges and Economic Development, provided information related to southbound bridge crossings by highlighting the upward trend in vehicle and pedestrian traffic. He added that the City would provide support at the Stanton and Bridge of the Americas in an effort to mitigate traffic and long wait times. Mr. Coronado also explained that El Paso International Airport traffic was similar to pre-pandemic levels and said the value of the peso was gradually recovering.
