

Additional Updates-Title 42



In March 2020, to slow the spread of COVID-19, CDC invoked Title 42, disallowing migrants from entering the country to seek asylum



Biden administration announced the end of Title 42 would be on May 23, 2022



A federal district court sitting in Louisiana granted a TRO keeping Title 42 in place

 TRO applies to all migrants including unaccompanied minors



A hearing for a preliminary injunction is set for May 13, 2022







Additional Updates-Travel Restrictions

Land

- On April 22, 2022, DHS added the requirement for persons entering through land POE's to provide proof of full vaccination before crossing into the U.S.
 - Does not apply to U.S. citizens, or Lawful Permanent Residents

Air

All international air travelers ages 2+ must continue to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test or documentation of recovery within the last 90 days before boarding their flight


- Community level continues LOW
