Additional Updates- Title 42



In March 2020, CDC invoked Title 42, disallowing migrants from entering the country to seek asylum .



Biden administration announced the end of Title 42 would be on May 23, 2022.



A Louisiana federal district court granted a TRO keeping Title 42 in place through May 13, 2022.

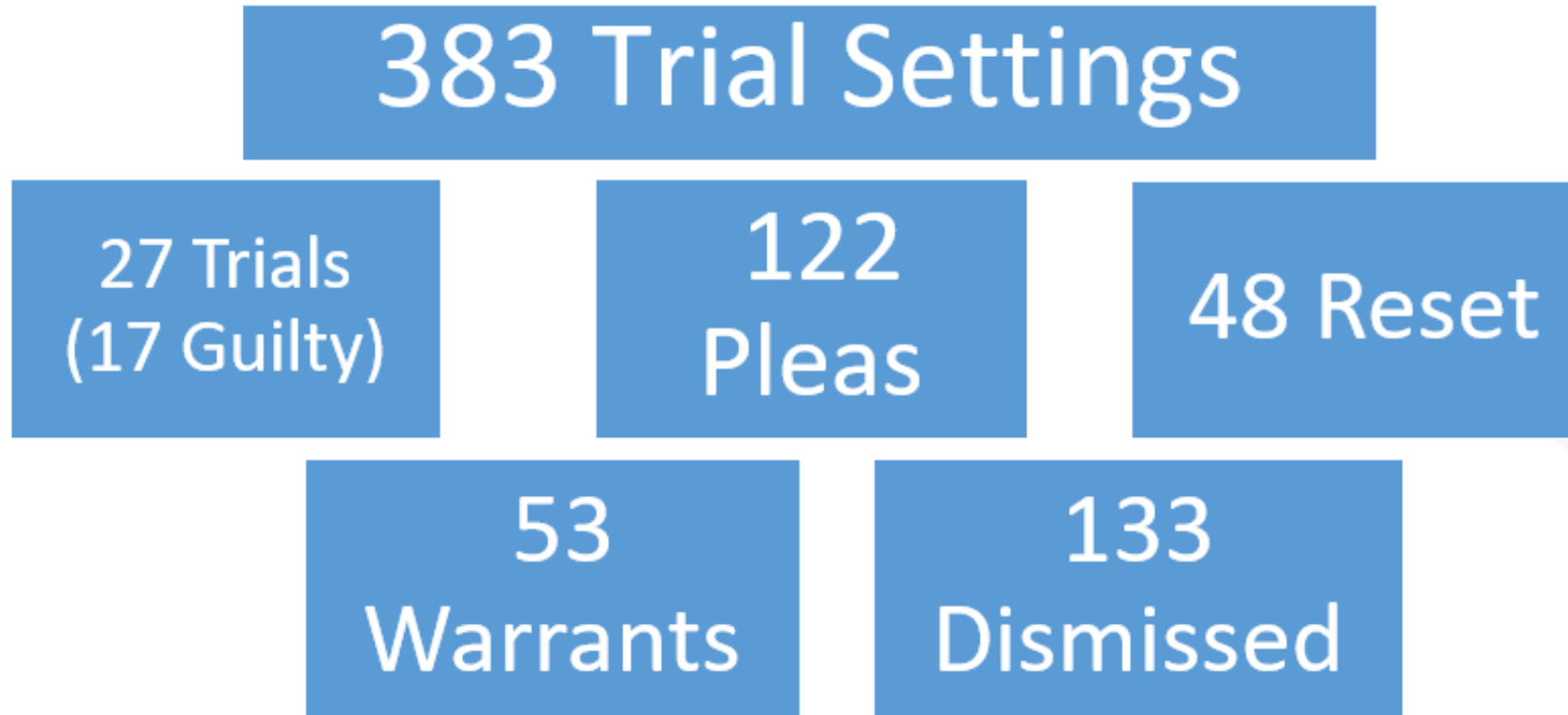


The TRO was extended to May 23rd or when the Court rules on a preliminary injunction.

Rate per 100k people

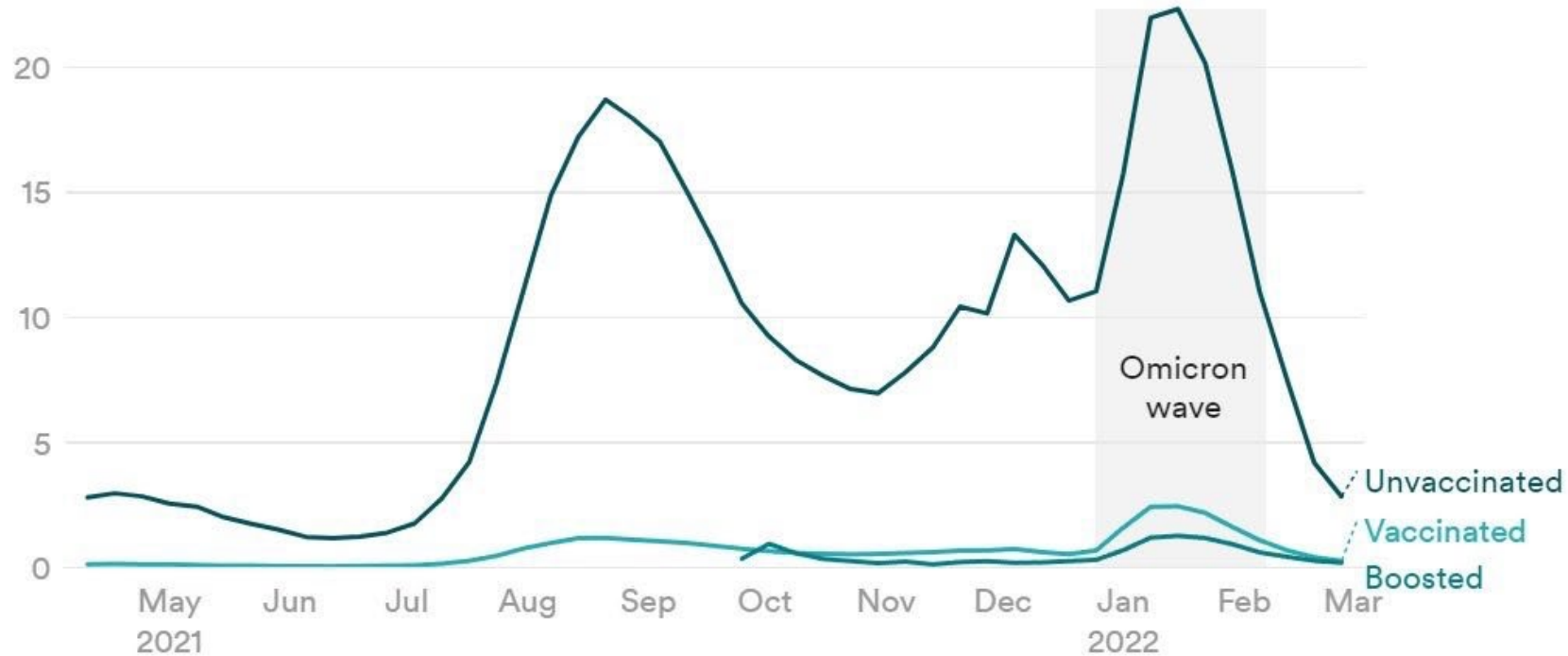
