Additional Updates Texas Supreme Court Emergency Order

52nd Emergency Order Regarding COVID-19

 Effective July 1, 2022- September 1, 2022 Continues to allow for remote hearings in all cases except some criminal jury proceedings

Relaxes health protocols for holding court proceedings Allows for courts to continue holding virtual hearings



Rederal Worker Vaccine Mandate

 Federal Worker Vaccine mandate is blocked pending further hearing on that case


Hector I. Ocaranza, M.D.

- Now administering vaccine to children 6 mo 5 years






