




COVID-19 Update

- Cases and Hospitalizations continue dropping
- New cases per capita have seen a decline of about 80% in 7 weeks
- New Hospitalizations have seen a nearly 60% decline in 7 weeks
- City COVID clinics are offering the new Bivalent vaccine to the public
- Schools are no longer required to report COVID data to DSHS





















Monkeypox Update

- El Paso has 2 confirmed cases so far
- The US and the state of TX have seen a decline in new cases
- Vaccination is an ongoing effort targeting high risk individuals
- 1 fatality reported in TX
- Information on prevention continues by the City across all social media platforms






Monkeypox in the US







Monkeypox in Texas







- Wash your hands often











Consumer Price Index Year-Over-Year (inflation) - U.S. City Average





El Paso BCI (unemployment rate, employment, wages, retail sales)





El Paso County Monthly Unemployment Rate





El Paso County Weekly Unemployment Insurance Claims (in thousands)




