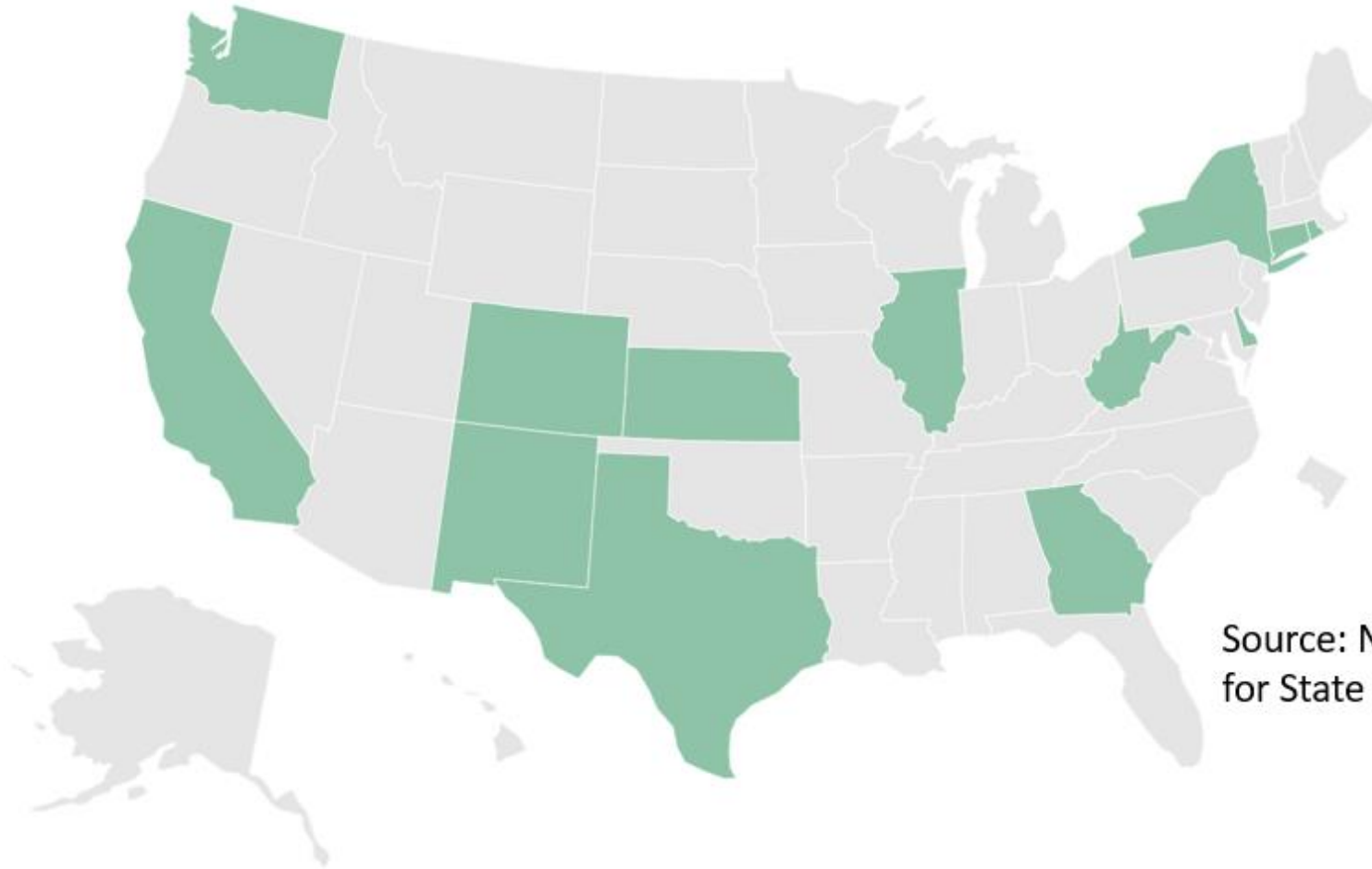

 - Notices for a "concerning COVID-19 variant" will still be issued



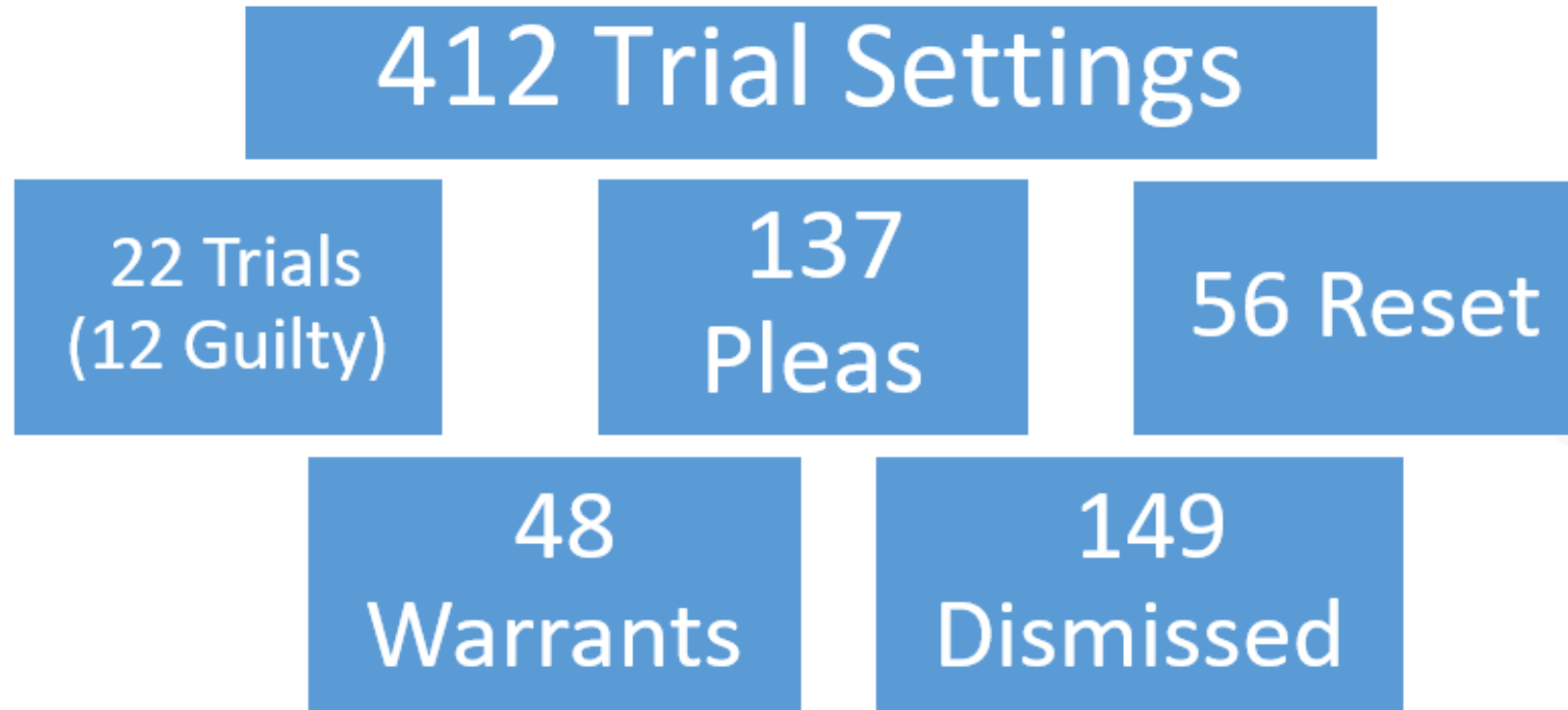
Additional Updates- Emergency Orders by State

Trial Settings on COVID-19 Citations through 9/29/2022 in all 5 Municipal Courts



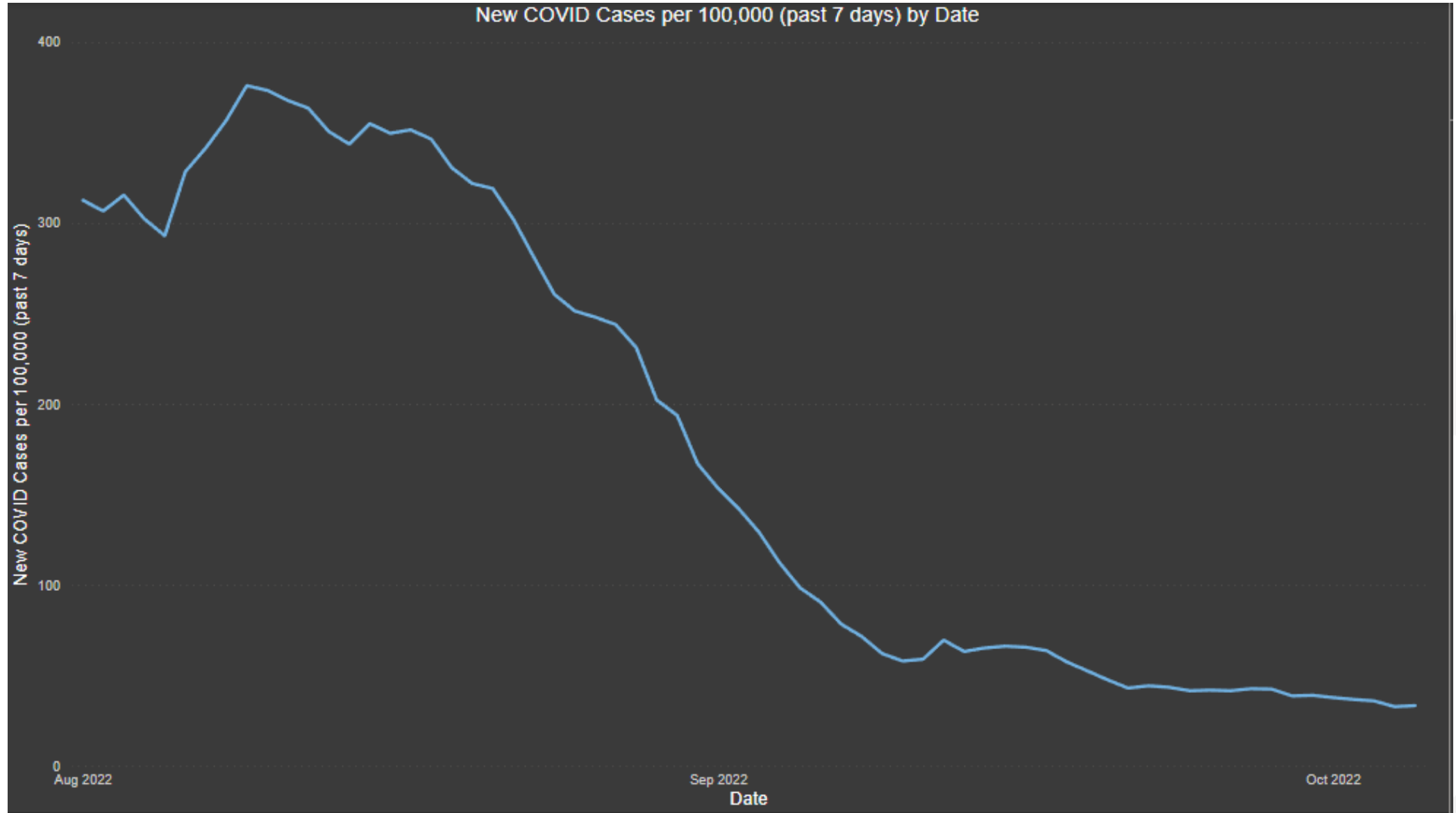


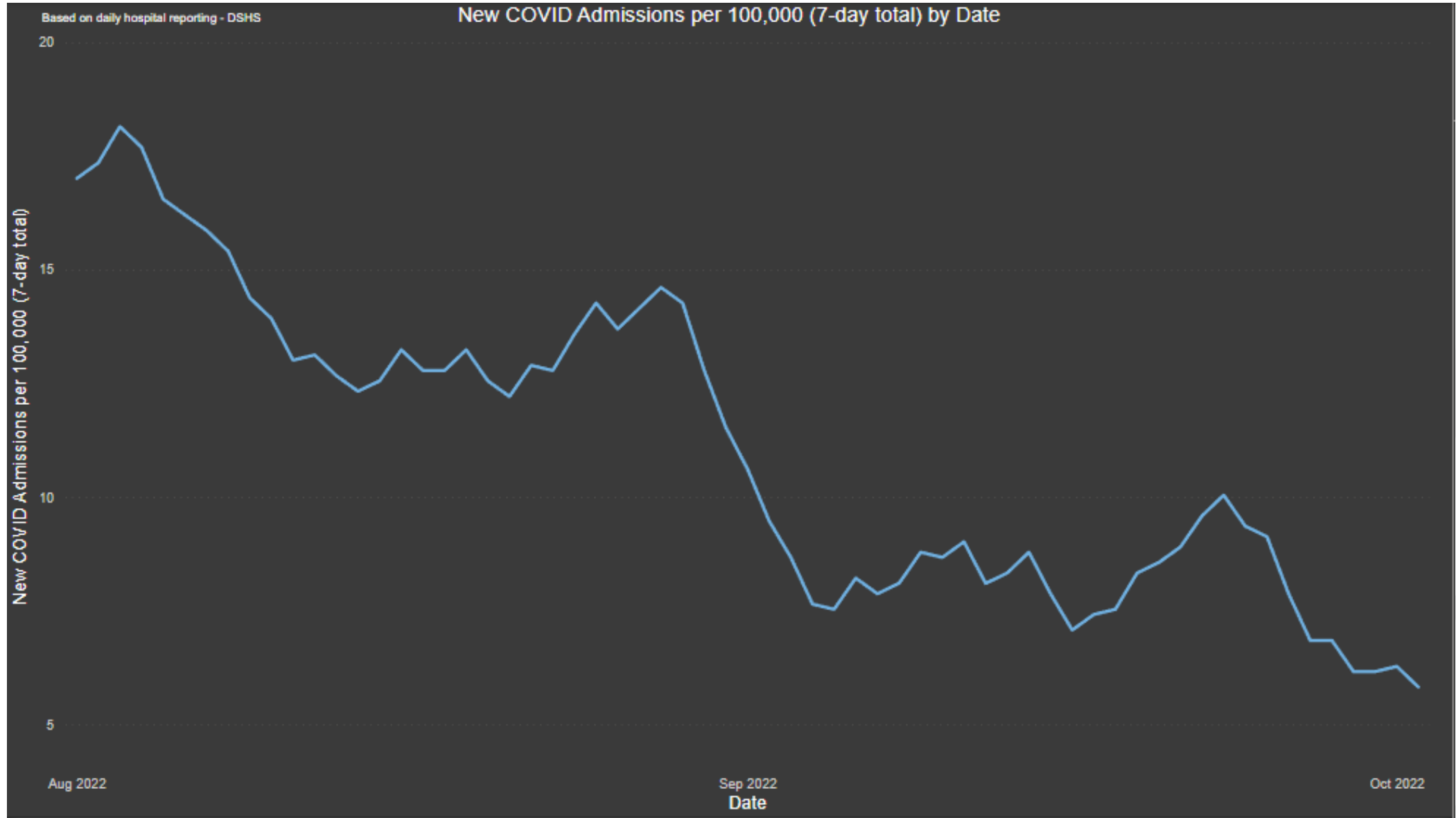

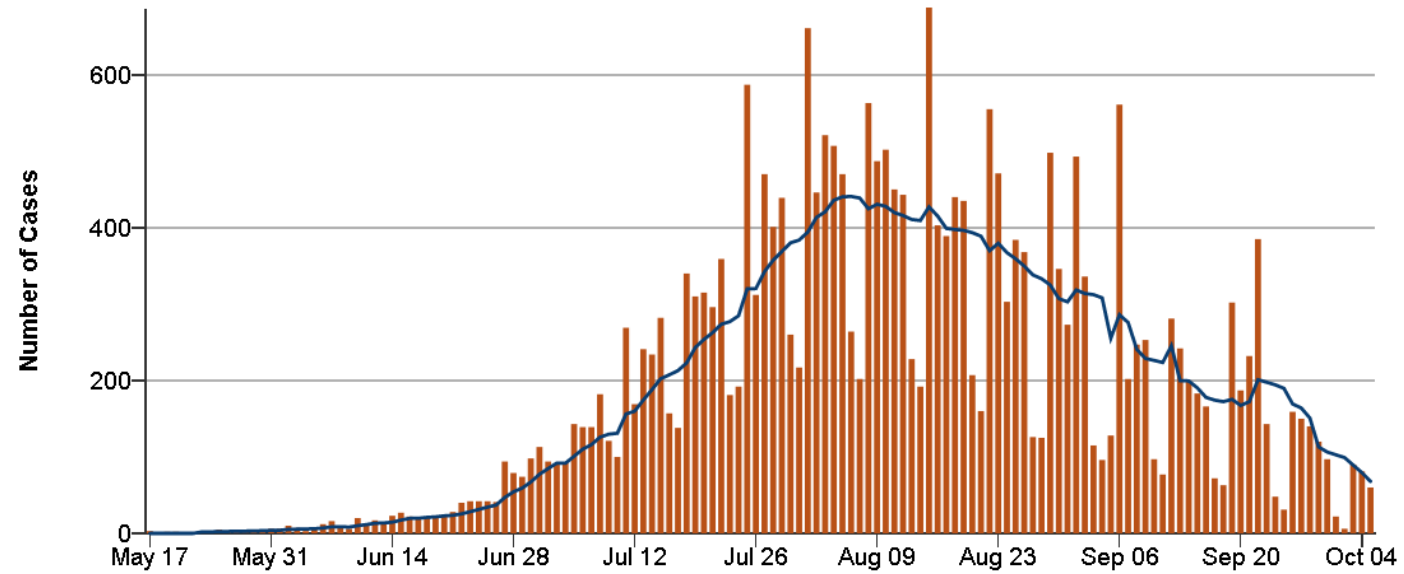
TEXAS COVID Cases



Monkeypox Cases

- El Paso continues with 2 confirmed cases
- In Texas 97% of cases are male
- Vaccination is ongoing prioritizing High Risk Individuals
- Collaborating closely with FQHC and other healthcare entities that care for high-risk individuals
- Vaccination will continue focusing on strategies to reach high-risk groups
- Vaccination not indicated for the general public
