

* Anticipated date **Anticipate Governor Abbott will renew his Disaster Declaration November 18-19, 2022.















Based on daily hospital reporting - DSHS

New COVID Admissions per 100,000 (7-day total) by Date












- El Paso continues with 2 confirmed cases
- In Texas 97% of cases are male
- Vaccination is ongoing prioritizing High Risk Individuals
- Collaborating closely with FQHC and other healthcare entities that care for high-risk individuals
- Vaccination will continue focusing on strategies to reach high-risk groups
- Vaccination not indicated for the general public
